1SEC. 2. INCREASED AGE LIMIT FOR EXEMPTION FROM2TANF PARTICIPATION RATE REQUIREMENTS.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 407(b)(5) of the Social
4 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 607(b)(5)) is amended by striking
5 "12 months" each place it appears and inserting "36
6 months".

7 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
8 subsection (a) shall apply to fiscal years beginning after
9 fiscal year 2012.
