Our nation's veterans *deserve our unequivocal commitment to ensuring that they receive the disability, health, education and other benefits they have earned*. I *do not support* increases in TRICARE premiums, deductibles and co-payments and will support efforts underway to look at the cost of sustaining Defense health care over the long term.
