Isakson Announces Recommendations for Water Resources Development Act

WASHINGTON – U.S. Senator Johnny Isakson, R-Ga., today announced his recommendation of Georgia projects to be authorized in the next *Water Resources Development Act*. Isakson believes these are critical water infrastructure projects for Georgia.

The *Water Resources Development Act* authorizes projects for funding but does not appropriate any federal dollars for them. Any project authorized under this Act will receive funding only if Congress later decides separately to appropriate federal dollars for it in the appropriations process.

Isakson's requests are listed in alphabetical order.

Savannah Harbor Expansion Project, to increase the authorized project cost from \$453,643,000 to \$651,857,000

Request is to increase to \$651,857,000 the authorization of the Savannah Harbor Expansion Project from \$453,643,000 as recommended by the Chief of Engineers, Army Corps of Engineers. The project was initially authorized in section 101(b)(9) of the Water Resources Development Act of 1999 (Pub. L. 106-53; 113 Stat. 279- 280). This is a request for increased authorization, and the project is still subject to appropriation for actual spending.
