TRIPS OUTSIDE OF THE UNITED STATES

Bring proof you kept ties to the United States during any trips longer than six months (rent or mortgage
payments and/or pay stubs). A single trip of six months or more may disqualify you for citizenship at this
time. USCIS requires that you be physically present in the US for at least 30 months if applying based
on five-year residency requirement and at least 18 months based on three-year residency
requirement. In addition, you must not have broken your continuous residency by being out of the
country more than six months in a single trip.
