

United States Service Academy Nominations for 2012 Application & Information for Potential Applicants

Congressional

Nominations

Members of Congress are authorized by law to nominate candidates for appointment to four U.S. Service Academies:

- The United States Air Force Academy
- The United States Military Academy
- The United States Naval Academy
- The United States Merchant Marine Academy

The 5th U.S. Service Academy, the United States Coast Guard Academy, does not require a Congressional nomination for appointment. However, upon completion of the application and interview process, a recommendation letter can be requested. These institutions prepare college-age Americans to be officers of the United States uniformed services. Upon graduation, U.S. Service Academy graduates are commissioned as officers in the active or reserve components of the U.S. Military, Merchant Marine, or Coast Guard for a minimum of five years.

Service Academy Requirements

As established by Federal law, applicants must meet the following requirements on July 1 of the year of admission to an academy:

1.	Age:	Be at least 17 years old, but not have passed their 23 rd birthday.
2.	Citizenship:	Be a United States citizen.
3.	Marital Status:	Be unmarried, not pregnant, and have no legal obligation to support children or other dependents.
4.	Scholastic:	Have graduated from high school. Contact our office for home school requirements. Typically applicants have SAT scores ranging from 550-650 verbal and 550-700 math or ACT scores ranging from 26-30 verbal and 27-31 math. Also, applicants are typically in the top 10% of their class, but all applicants in the
_		upper 40% are considered.
5.	Domicile:	Reside in the Second Congressional District of Colorado to receive to receive a nomination from Congressman Jared Polis.
6.	Physical:	Review requirements for the U.S. Service Academy of your choice. Please note appointment offers may be conditional based on your medical exam.

Test Score Guidelines

The following scores represent the minimum requirements for the standardized testing portion of your application to the Air Force, Merchant Marine, Naval Academy, and Military Academy (West Point). The following scores were established by the academies themselves, and confirm with the academy directly for the year you are applying.

Application Instructions

In order to be considered for a nomination, the following items must be submitted.

Part 1

- U.S. Service Academy Candidate Summary Sheet-See interactive PDF Form
- Photograph: Attached to the U.S. Service Academy Candidate Summary Sheet. If not, send as a PNG or JPEG image; or mail. Please consider the professional nature of this application when selecting a photograph.
- **Basic application:** personal information, Certification of Accuracy and Understanding form, and optional demographic questionnaire.
- Personal letter, explaining to Congressman Polis your reasons for seeking a nomination to a U.S. Service Academy. Include why you have chosen this career path and how you contribute as a cadet or midshipman.
- Attach a **resume** to provide additional information regarding employment, volunteer activities, sports, etc.
- Two (2) **essays:** Limit your responses to each question below to no more than two pages, double-spaced. Although the content of your essays is most important, you will also be evaluated based on essential writing skills. If you are submitting your application electronically, you may submit your essays as a separate attachment.

Essay Questions:

- 1. Please state two specific experiences that will prepare you to be successful and graduate from a service academy.
- 2. What do you think of the honor code in today's service academy? How is the honor code different in a service academy than what you might experience in a civilian school?

Part 2

- Complete and send the **reference form** with your three (3) references.
- For your recommendations, give a **Nomination Reference Form**, that has the Polis Boulder office mailing address.
- One (1) of these recommendations must be completed by a teacher, principal or *counselor*. Recommendations should be completed by someone who knows you well (coach, mentor, etc.), but *not* by a family member.

Part 3

• **Official copy** of your **high school transcript:** The transcript may be included with your application if it is a certified original. Otherwise ask your school to send it directly to Congressman Polis' Boulder office. If you are currently a college student planning to transfer to a U.S. Service Academy, please send your most recent college transcript in addition to your high school transcript. *Providing an altered or false transcript will result in your application being dismissed without further consideration.*

Part 4

• Official ACT and/or SAT scores: If your official ACT and/or SAT scores are included on your official transcript, you do not need to send separately. Otherwise, these scores need to be sent directly to the Boulder office by the due date. *Providing an altered or false report of test scores will result in your application being dismissed without further consideration.*
