Pete King (pictured center) joined with the Nassau County Police Department and the NYPD at the Queens-Nassau border on Sunrise Highway during a joint exercise to detect nuclear devices and dirty bombs. Rep. King led the successful fight on the House floor to restore \$30 million to the “**Secure the Cities**” program (H.R. 2638) which provides state of the art radiation detection technology to police departments in high threat areas such as New York City and Long Island.

REP. KING SUPPORTS ENGLISH LANGUAGE
