Summary of H.R. 802, as amended Directing the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to Establish a VetStar Award Program

Title: To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to establish a VetStar Award Program.

Mr. Filner of California introduced H.R. 802 on February 18, 2011.

H.R. 802, as amended, would:

- Require the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to establish an award program to annually recognize businesses for their contributions to veterans' employment.
- Require VA to develop the award criteria, advertise the program, review nominations, and select winners.
