

 - 6 of top 10 U.S. trading partners






If visa restrictions were loosened and direct flights increased, the U.S. could see 5 million visitors from China.



Where are they headed? China Traveler Destinations




Riding the Wave of Growth: Increased Numbers of Visitors 2004-2010

- August 2007 New law allows South Korea to join U.S. visa waiver program.

- Videoconference pilot program








VISIT USA Act of 2011 Projected Economic Impact for Hawaii*






