

MILITARY ACADEMY APPOINTMENTS THE OFFICE OF CONGRESSMAN TIMOTHY V. JOHNSON THE 15th Congressional District of Illinois

To be accepted into a military academy, a student must first be nominated by one of three sources: their US Congressman; one of their US Senators; or, the Vice President. A student must reside within the district at the time of a nomination. There are three academies for which these rules apply: the US Naval Academy in Annapolis, Maryland; the US Air Force Academy in Colorado Springs, Colorado; and, the US Military Academy at West Point in New York.

Each congressman can have 5 students "charged" to him at one time at each academy. For each slot, he may nominate up to ten people.

Congressman Johnson uses the "competitive nomination" process for his slate. He submits to the academies an unranked slate of up to ten nominations for each vacancy. The academies will then decide from the ten names we send whom they want to accept. Congressman Johnson normally fills only <u>one</u> vacancy per year at each academy.

We ask that students fill out an application form, send in their ACT and SAT scores, their school transcripts, a small picture of themselves and at least three letters of recommendation from adults who know them well. We ask that this be in by **November 16th, 2012**.

After decisions are made, the names are forwarded to the academies based on rules provided by them. The students are notified in January by a letter from the Congressman.
