COMMITTEE ACTION

The Committee on Natural Resources met in open session on Wednesday, December 5, 2012, to consider the following bills:

H.R. 6364, To establish a commission to ensure a suitable observance of the centennial of World War I, to designate memorials to the service of members of the United States Armed Forces in World War I, including a National World War I Memorial on the National Mall in the District of Columbia, and for other purposes. *"Frank Buckles World War I Memorial Act"*

The Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests and Public Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 6364.

- An amendment offered by Mr. Bishop of Utah.084 was AGREED TO by unanimous consent.
- The long title was amended by unanimous consent.

Adopted and favorably reported to the House of Representatives, as amended, by unanimous consent.

H.R. 752, To amend the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act to designate segments of the Molalla River in the State of Oregon, as components of the National Wild and Scenic Rivers System, and for other purposes. "Molalla River Wild and Scenic Rivers Act"

The Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests and Public Lands was discharged from further consideration of H.R. 752.

 An amendment offered by Mr. Bishop of Utah.086 was AGREED TO by unanimous consent.

Adopted and favorably reported to the House of Representatives, as amended, by unanimous consent.

S. 3193, To make technical corrections to the legal description of certain land to be held in trust for the Barona Band of Mission Indians, and for other purposes. "Barona Band of Mission Indians Land Transfer Clarification Act of 2012"

The Subcommittee on Indian and Alaska Native Affairs was discharged from further consideration of S. 3193.

Adopted and favorably reported to the House of Representatives by unanimous consent.
