Dear Senator Stabenow and Senator Levin:

Thank you for your letter of October 19, 2010 regarding the progress Ontario municipalities have made in meeting their 2006 commitment to eliminate all municipally managed waste shipments to Michigan by the end of 2010.

While I was not in my current position in 2006 when this agreement was reached, I would like to stress that I share your views related to the importance of this agreement and want to assure you that I take these commitments very seriously.

At the time of the agreement, all four Toronto area municipalities (City of Toronto, York Region, Durham Region and Peel Region) were shipping waste to Michigan landfills. These municipalities committed to:

- o reducing their waste shipments to Michigan by 20 percent by the end of 2007;
- o reducing their waste shipments to Michigan by 40 percent by the end of 2008; and
- o a complete end to shipments at the end of 2010.

I am pleased to inform you that these municipalities have all ceased shipping their waste to Michigan as of December 2010, as per their 2006 commitments.

These municipalities have been able to stop their waste shipments to Michigan because of:

- the municipalities having secured long-term disposal options for their waste that do not involve Michigan landfills; and
- o their expansion of waste diversion programs.
