





I, Malcolm B. Higgins, II, Assistant Counsel for the Atlantic Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command, Norfolk, Virginia, do hereby certify that I have examined all of the unclassified records, affecting the title to the property hereinafter described, of the Atlantic Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command, in Norfolk, Virginia, which is the cognizant office in charge of real estate records of the Department of the Navy pertaining to said property; that such examination included a careful and diligent search for all instruments, correspondence, and other information affecting title to the property; that based upon the examination, it is hereby certified that a fee simple estate in said lands and the improvements thereon are vested in the United States of America with no liens, encumbrances or restrictions thereon, except those contained in this report.

A. LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF EXCESS PROPERTY:

The property proposed to be declared excess is located on the Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune, North Carolina. Said property consists of two separate parcels of land containing a total of 1.31 acres of land, more or less, as shown respectively on P. W. Drawing No. 13421, last revised on 16 June 1976, entitled "MARINE CORPS BASE, CAMP LEJEUNE, NORTH CAROLINA, EXCESS PROPERTY WELL SITE NO. 6", attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and P. W. Drawing No. 13422, last revised on 16 June 1976, entitled "MARINE CORPS BASE, CAMP LEJEUNE, NORTH CAROLINA, EXCESS PROPERTY WELL SITE NO. 7", attached hereto as Exhibit "B". Said parcels of land are more particularly described as follows:

PARCEL A: Well Site No. 6 (0.56 of an acre)

Beginning at a point in the easterly right-of-way line of the Camp Lejeune Railroad, said point being the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING of Parcel A herein and being N 130 23' E, 55.5 feet from a point in the centerline of the Camp Lejeune Railroad, said point in the centerline of the Camp Lejeune Railroad being N 320 45' W, 2,150.0 feet from the centerline of westbound roadway of N. C. Highway No. 24 (centerline of original Highway No. 24); thence from the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING along and with the run of Scales Creek (formerly referred to as Ellis Branch) the following courses and distances: N 130 23' E, 61.56 feet; thence N 12° 47' W, 25.50 feet; thence N 46° 28' W, 28.29 feet; thence N 00° 14' E, 6.45 feet; thence N 59° 50' E, 55.79 feet; thence N 20° 12' W, 20.29 feet; thence, leaving Scales Creek, N 320 45' W, 170.27 feet to a point; thence S 570 15' W, 110.00 feet to a point in the right-of-way line of the Camp Lejeune Railroad; thence along said right-of-way line S 32° 45' E, 286.56 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING, containing 0.56 of an acre, more or less, and being that same parcel of land, Well Site No. 6, described in Book 276, Page 137, Jacksonville Township, Onslow County, North Carolina; TOGETHER WITH an easement over a certain trash

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road leading from new highway (known as the Bell Fork Road) formerly referred to as Neck Road and running southwest a distance of approximately 300 yards over said trash road located on the lands of Grantors to Well No. 6.

PARCEL B: Well Site No. 7 (0.75 of an acre)

Beginning at a point in the easterly right-of-way line of the Camp Lejeune Railroad, said point being the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING of Parcel B herein and being N 40° 46' E, 43.0 feet from a point in the centerline of the Camp Lejeune Railroad, said point in the centerline of the Camp Lejeune Railroad being N 320 13' W, 4,179.2 feet from the centerline of westbound roadway of N. C. Highway No. 24 (centerline of original Highway No. 24); thence from the described TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING N 400 46' E, 169.17 feet to a point in the westerly right-of-way line of Bell Fork Road; thence with the right-of-way line of said road N 490 16' W, 101.43 feet; thence N 43° 48' W, 103.09 feet; thence N 37° 29' W, 81.82 feet to the run of Big Branch (formerly referred to as Scales Creek); thence with the run and along the centerline of Big Branch S 190 05' W, 58.30 feet; thence 3 490 10' W, 30.00 feet to a point in the easterly right-of-way line of the Camp Lejeune Railroad; thence with said rightof-way line S 25° 33' E, 107.18 feet; thence S 26° 52' E, 99.34 feet; thence S 27° 49' E, 83.98 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING, containing 0.75 of an acre, more or less, and being that same parcel of land, Well Site No. 7, described in Book 276, Page 137, Jacksonville Township, Onslow County, North Carolina.

B. ACQUISITION OF TITLE BY THE UNITED STATES:

Title to the aforedescribed lands was acquired by the United States of America by Corporation Deed dated 3 June 1958 from Tarawa Terrace, Inc. to United States of America, recorded among the Land Records of Jacksonville Township, Onslow County, North Carolina, in Deed Book 276 at page 137, a copy of the relevant portions of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "C".

C. OUTSTANDING INTERESTS AND RESTRICTIONS:

None.

D. JURISDICTION:

The records of the Atlantic Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command do <u>not</u> contain any document whereby the United States of America has ever purported to accept jurisdiction over the lands herein proposed to be declared excess. The jurisdictional status of the subject lands is therefore proprietary only.
