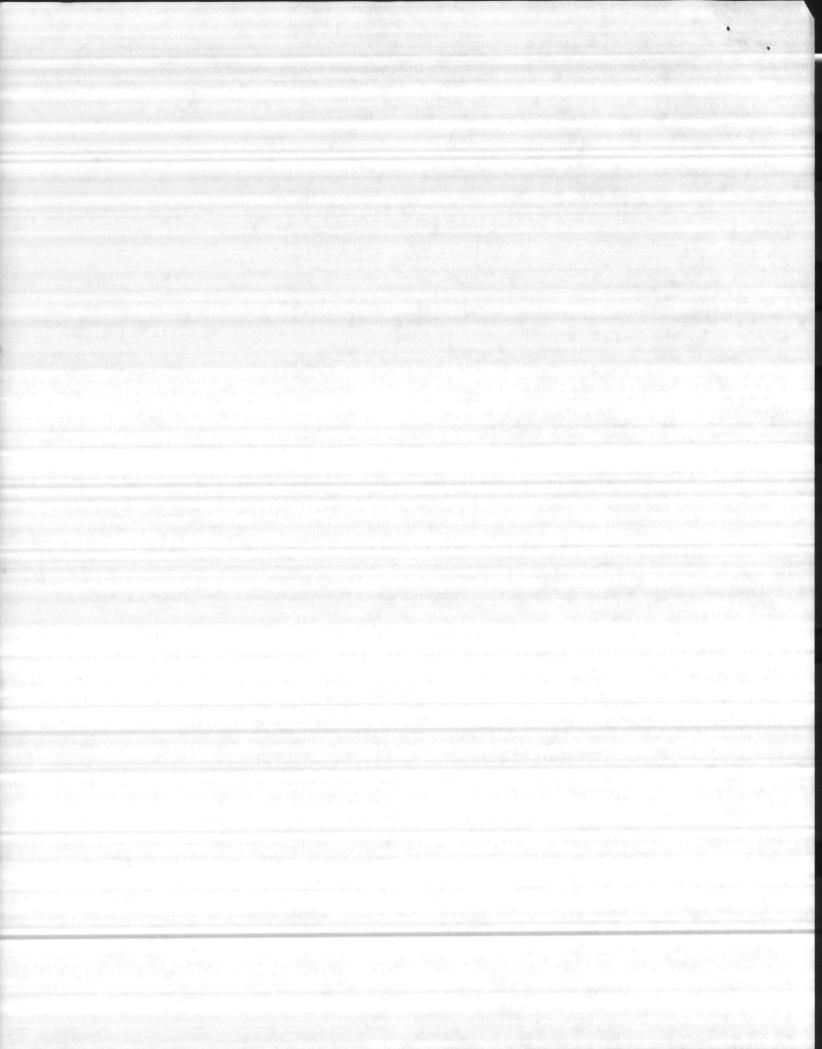
The Resources Board for Financial Advisory Functions met on 1. 29 October 1987 to review the subject ceilings. Enclosure (1) provides the final approved ceilings.

1. Under the "Manage to Payroll" program established by reference (a), civilian compensation (OC-11) funding), position management and employee classification are the controlling factors in managing civilian manpower.

2. When managers are granted authority to manage civilian employees by classification, compensation and position management, they become directly responsible for ensuring that authorization levels are not exceeded. Reference (b) provides implementing instructions for managing to payroll and contains financial planning guidance for ensuring that expenditures stay within approved levels.

3. Reference (c) states that the OC-11 financial target for managing to payroll has been received for the command level and that the Comptroller is in the process of assigning targets to individual fund administrators. Further, a preliminary review of the command target indicates fund administrators will receive a target based on last years (FY87) average man year cost multiplied by this years (FY88) LOA, less two percent, although it may be more or less for an individual fund administrator. Additionally, reference (c) states the Comptroller does not have the flexibility to provide the Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs Division a target based on the upgraded billets. However, if excess target becomes available during the year from your department or other fund administrators, the target will be increased.

4. Advisory classification opinions have been provided by the Classification Branch, Civilian Personnel Division on the positions referred to by reference (d). Based on paragraph 3 above, the classification opinions and subject to the availability of civilian labor target (OC-11 funding) within the Facilities Department to support the increased labor cost, reference (d)

is approved. Since civilian labor target is the controlling factor under manage to payroll, the AC/S, Facilities should take every action possible to remain within assigned target, otherwise future personnel actions affecting the civilian work force within the department may be necessary to offset any excess expenditures incurred as a result of these upgrades.
