



Dear Sir:

This letter is to report an 18 March 1985 break in a sewer main in the Hadnot Point wastewater treatment system. Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune, Morth Carolina. Telephonic notification was made to your office on 19 March 1985. Mr. Bush of your staff made an on-site inspection on 20 March 1985. Approximately 2,000 gallons of sewage were spilled when a contractor collecting soil samples broke the line. None appeared to reach the New River. The site was treated with ETE and cleaned up. It was repaired by 3:307M on 18 March 1985.



NPDES PERMIT VIOLATION, BB-204 and TC-563

1. The Courthouse Bay Wastewater Treatment Plant violated the parameter for percent removal of BOD and SS for the month of February 1985, parameters being 85% removal. Actual BOD removal was 81.9% and SS removal was 83.6% for the month.

2. The Camp Geiger Wastewater Treatment Plant violated the parameter for percent removal of BOD for the month of February 1985, parameter being 85% removal. Actual BOD removal was 83.1% for the month.

- 3. The trickling filters for both plants were under contract to replace filter sweeps and center column. Due to the time required for replacement, the zoogleal film on filter media was destroyed which takes approximately two weeks to reclaim.
- 4. Filters at both plants are back in normal operation and permit requirements are being met.




