- Returned, approved.
- 2. All future requests for use of a fire hydrant to clean equipment will be granted only when the following conditions exist:
- a. Weather and terrain conditions make it impractical to use another unit's wash facility.
  - b. Tactical fire trucks are not available from 2d FSSG.
- A proper hydrant wrench is used to open the hydrant valve.
- Vehicle washdown on your lot is not environmentally sanctioned because of the run off into a freshwater stream. Using a fire hydrant is especially undesirable because of the large volume of water it produces. A project is funded and under design to construct an acceptable washdown facility at your building this fiscal year. Until that is completed, however, I urge you to seek alternate sources whenever possible.
- 4. By copy hereof, the Base Pire Chief is directed to approve future requests of this nature only when the above conditions are met.


