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





This Activity has a total land and water area of 110,503 acres; 95,000 acres of which are suitable for fish and wildlife; and 60,065 acres for forest management. The discrepancy in acreage figures from FY-74 to FY-75 is due to the fact that 373 acres were excessed by GSA, 190 acres of which were under forest management. Program elements are forest management, fish and wildlife management, and soil and water conservation.

The Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs Division of Base Maintenance Department is responsible for all natural resources management, which includes supervision and/or coordination of all natural resources activities.

Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs Management is organized as depicted below:





A brief summary of the natural resources program for Fiscal Year 1974 to date follows:

#### FOREST MANAGEMENT

Forest inventory and management plan development is nearing completion. All field work has been accomplished and 85% of stand mapping is completed. The narrative portion of the plan should be completed and ready for reproduction by the Soil Conservation Service by the end of FY-74.

Planting has been completed in compartments 41 and 29 and will be completed in compartment 42 in May.

A contract for site preparation has been re-financed, resubmitted, advertised and bids will be opened on 25 April.

Due to extremely wet weather in the winter of FY-73, prescribed burning on four compartments was incomplete. Burning on these four compartments and the twelve scheduled compartments was completed in early March.

For FY-74 to date 4,441 MBF of sawtimber and 6,161 cords of pulpwood were harvested for a total of \$729,778. Due to southern pine beetle damage, 812.4 MBF and 2,081 cords of this total were harvested. A more detailed report will be included in FY-74 Natural Resources Summary and Statistical Reports.


#### FISH AND WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT

One hundred and twelve acres of winter grain were established at fifty-six locations for deer and wild turkey. Each planting averaged two acres in size. Winter grain was also established in forty foot strips in dove fields to increase dove nesting activity adjacent to the fields during summer. A new wildlife food plot was established through clearing and discing for planting preparation. The new plot totals two acres in size. Thirty wildlife openings were maintained by mowing in late winter to prevent woody succession. Thirty wild turkeys were live-trapped in a cooperative project by state and Base personnel for restocking three new areas in North Carolina. Forty wild turkeys were live-trapped, banded, and released on the area as part of a population study. Eight black bear were live-trapped, tagged and released as part of a telemetry study.

Ten fresh water ponds were managed for fishing. Henderson Pond, constructed in 1971, was opened for fishing on 2 July 1973. Very good fishing results from this pond were reported throughout the season.

# SOIL, WATER AND POLLUTION ABATEMENT


In FY-74 field work on the soil and water portion of the Long-range Multiple Use Natural Resources Management Plan was begun with technical assistance being provided by the Soil Conservation Service. Base environmental personnel are working closely with representatives of the Soil Conservation Service in developing this plan.

During FY-74 the pollution abatement program moved forward at Camp Lejeune with the modification and installation of forty tanks for storage of waste oil at the unit level. A 272,000 gallon storage tank was renovated and is receiving the oil collected from the forty unit tanks.

Approximately 600 Marines of Motor Transport School have been exposed to a slide/lecture presentation on the environment at Camp Lejeune with emphasis placed on oil pollution and its prevention.

The salvage of wood ammunition boxes and other scrap lumber by Defense Property Disposal was begun as a result of encouragement by environmental personnel.



## FY-75 ANNUAL INGREMENT OF THE LONG-RANGE FOREST RESOURCE MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR MARINE CORPS BASE, CAMP LEJEUNE, NORTH CAROLINA

This Activity has a total land area of 60,065 acres under forest management. Effective 1 July 1974, New River Air Station and Oak Grove, an outlying auxiliary field, will be absorbed by the Forestry Section for management. The additional acreage will be approximately 1,200 acres and 975 acres respectively. Total forest land to be managed will be 62,240 acres; however, no increment for New River and Oak Grove is included in this document. The Base Forestry Branch personnel consists of one GS-11, one GS-7, one GS-5, two GS-4's and two GS-3's. Forestry operations are indicated by compartments and stand numbers for the forest land involved for treatment, and are listed by cost account codes and fund requirements as follows:

### FOREST MANAGEMENT

3B10 Timber Management. Personnel included will perform operations such as forest management plan preparation, planning, compartment prescriptions, general inspection and supervision, reporting and other administrative management functions.


## FY-75 ANNUAL OPERATIONAL PLAN FOR FISH AND WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT

This increment established annual project work plans under the Long-Range Plan and consistent with major land uses of the area (listed by numerical priority). All fish and wildlife management projects will be accomplished by station personnel. The Wildlife Branch consists of one GS-9 Technician, one GS-4 Technician, one Gunnery Sergeant and one Sergeant.

1. <u>Wildlife Management</u>. Personnel included will perform such duties as fish and wildlife inventory, planning, compartment prescription, general supervision, and other administrative management functions.
