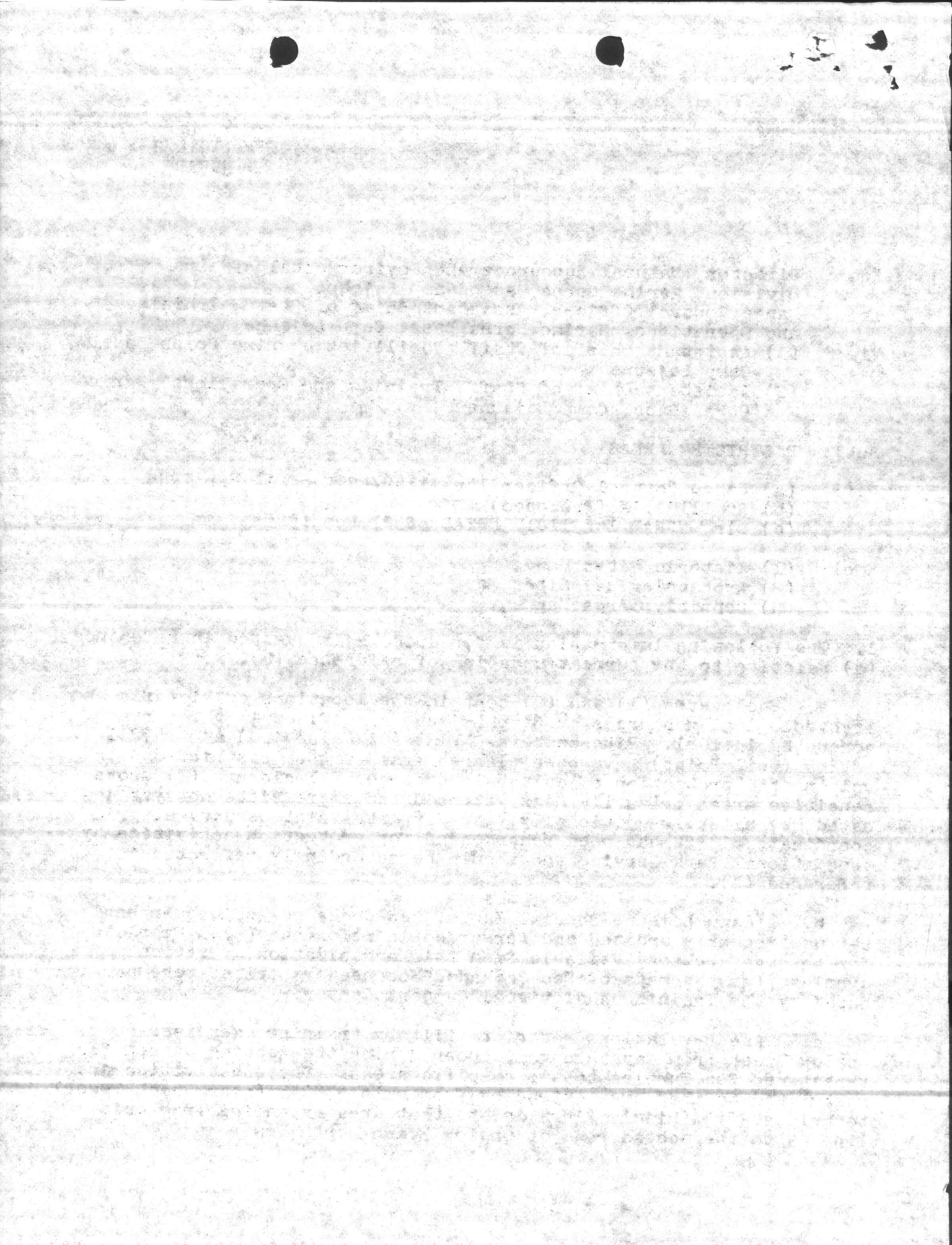

1. The following information is forwarded as requested in reference (a) relative to the current updating of reference (b).

a. Enclosures (1) and (2) contain the locations of historic and archaeological resources at Camp Lejeune as defined in the survey conducted in 1981. Site numbers ONV138 (TLZ Bluebird) and ONV251-ONV265 (Well Point) have been cleared from further restrictions involving the protection of cultural resources. Enclosure (3) shows sensitive areas primarily near watercourses where sites not yet located may exist. Additionally, the Jarretts Point Ossuary at grid coordinate 819302 has been recommended for protection activities by the National Park Service and should be accordingly reflected in reference (b).

b. A Camp Lejeune Special Map of Red-Cockaded Woodpecker habitat was recently updated and forwarded in reference (c). Overlays for the map are not available from this organization. Previous overlays for the maps of Red-Cockaded Woodpecker habitat were produced by the Training Audiovisual Support Center.

c. Base regulations restrict military training exercises on Onslow Beach from May through October during the nesting season for threatened Sea Turtles to two specific areas. These activities are restricted to that area extending from grid 878245 (near South Tower) to grid 903263 (Risely Pier) and to that area extending from grid line 29 to the access road at Onslow Beach North Tower.

d. Endangered Alligators may be found in any of the fresh or saltwater areas within the confines of Camp Lejeune. All these water areas are shown on the special map and could be referenced in the text as areas where endangered Alligators may be found.

e. Twelve freshwater ponds have been developed for recreational fishing. Base fishing regulations currently prohibit the dumping of chemicals or explosives in these ponds. It is recommended that these regulations be included in reference (b) in these ponds at the following locations:
