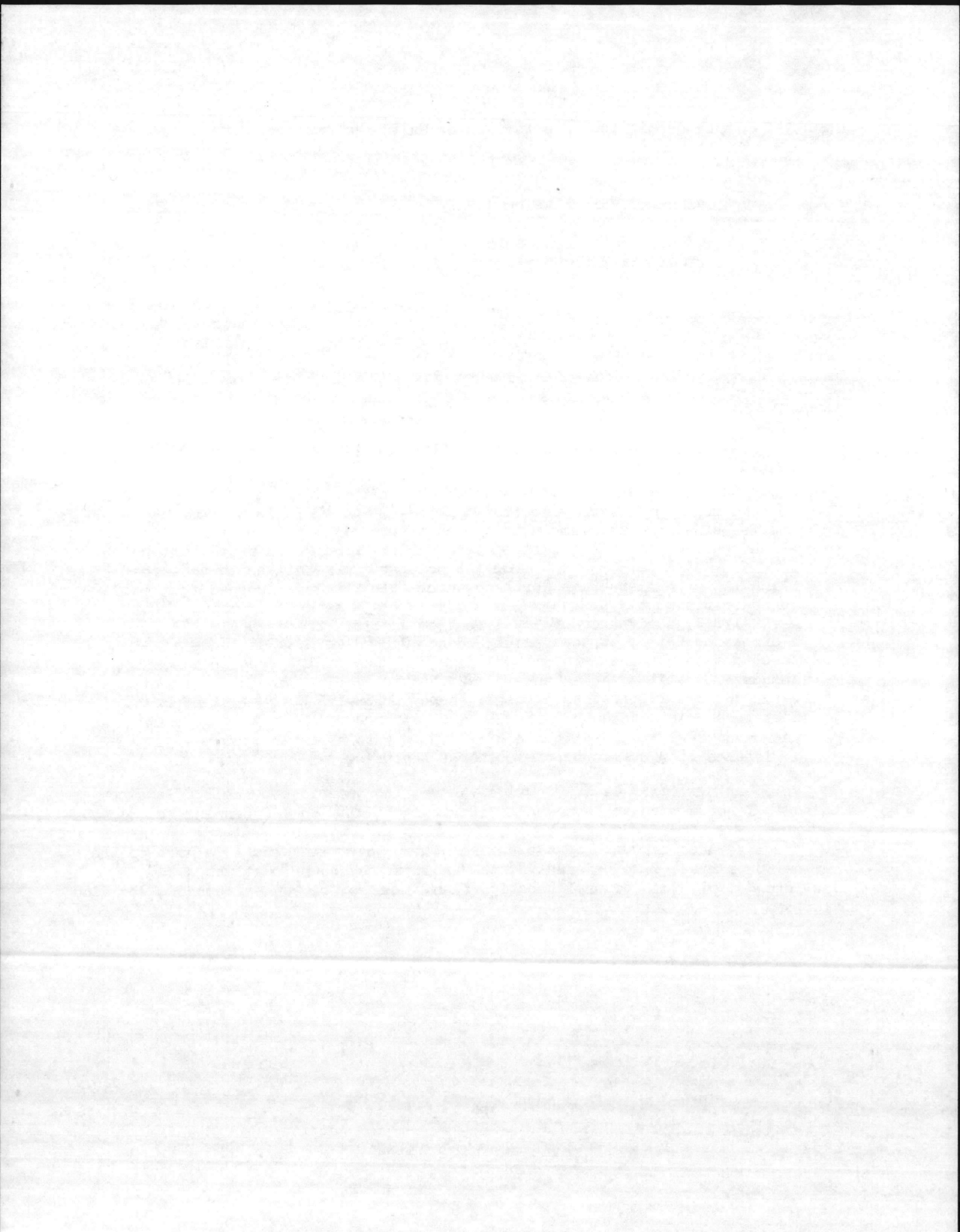
1. Permission is hereby granted to the Housing and Home Finance Agency, its representatives, contractors and agents, access and right-of-entry to the following described site for the purpose of performing all acts and functions necessary in construction and provision of an All-Purpose Room, services and utilities at the Midway Park Primary School, Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune, North Carolina. Permission is also granted to make such connections to existing Government owned facilities as may be required in connection with the work.

The site is a tract of land described as follows:

"Beginning at a concrete monument which is in the north line of Butler Drive North, and which stands 40 feet at right angles from the center line of said road, and which also stands N 58°-17' E, 42.75 feet from the intersection of said centerline with the said centerline of a culvert pipe which crosses the center line of said Butler Drive North at a point which is S 51°-43' E, 245.35 feet from the point of curve of the turnout road which leaves Butler Drive North to enter Third Street; proceed from said concrete monument N 51°-43' W, a distance of 55 feet to a point, thence N 38°-17' E, a distance of 162.5 feet to a point; thence S 51°-43' E, a distance of 55 feet to a point; thence N 38°-17' E, a distance of 42 feet to a point; thence S 51°-43' E, a distance of 170 feet to a point; thence S 38°-17' W, a distance of 42 feet to a point; thence S 51°-43' E, a distance of 132 feet to a point; thence S 38°-17' E, a distance of 14 feet to a point; thence S 51°-43' E, a distance of 68 feet to a point; thence S 38°-17' W, a distance of 148.5 feet to a point; thence N 51°-43' W, a distance of 370 feet to the point of beginning."

3. All bearings refer to N. C. Grid System. The described parcel of land contains 1.71 acres more or less and is shown graphically on Y&D Drawing No. 613479.

4. The land area is owned by the United States Government and is a part of the Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, as shown on attached Y&D Drawings No. 613498, "General Location Plan," and No. 613499, "Proposed, Revision Plat and Boundary Survey."

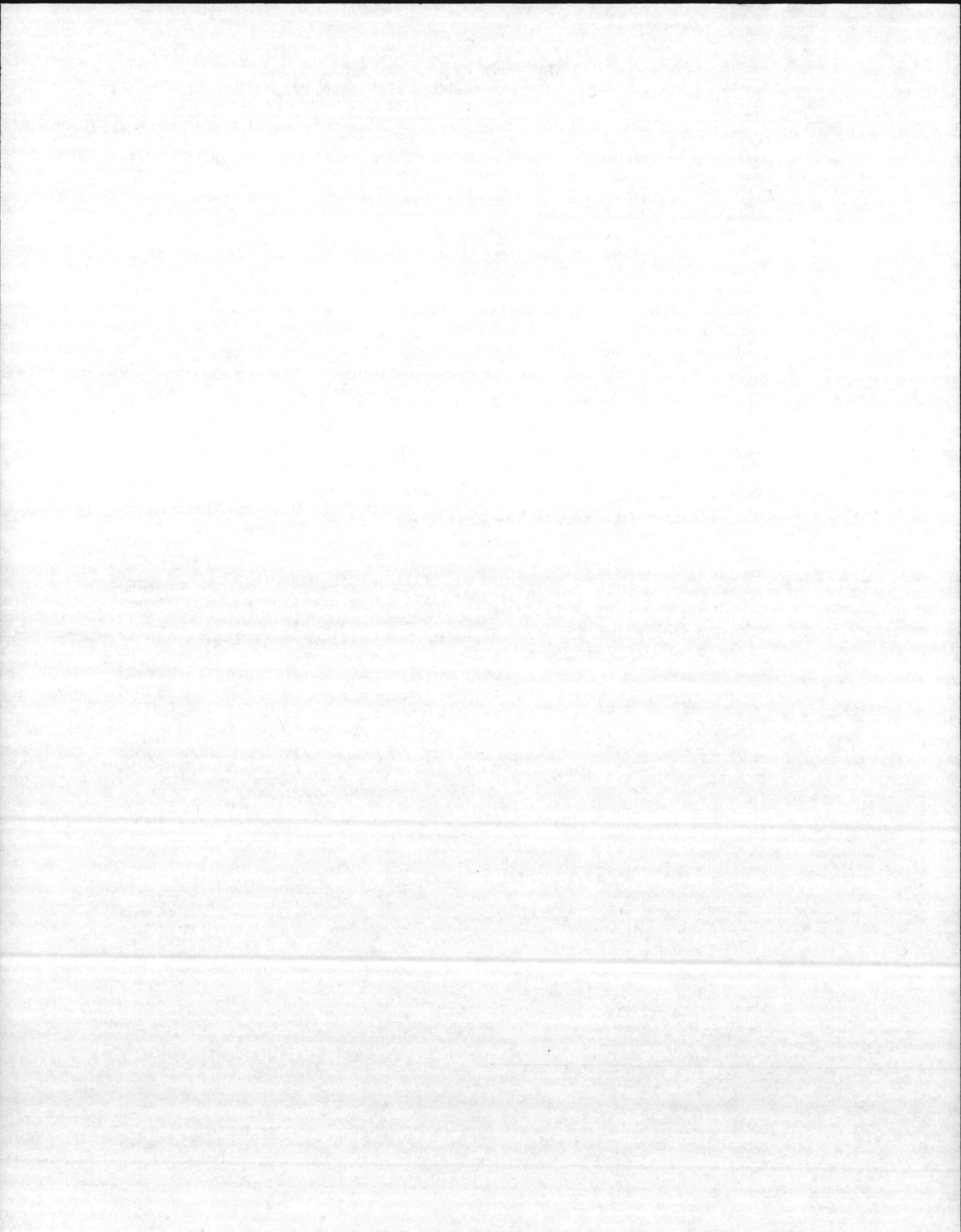

1. Problem:

School buildings and facilities located at Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, are owned either by the Marine Corps or the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare. The buildings and facilities owned by the Marine Corps are on permit to the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare, who in turn issued a permit to us to use and occupy for school purposes our own buildings and facilities for which they budget for maintenance and operations.

2. Background:

A. Enclosure (1) gave permission to the Commissioner of Education, Department of Health, Education, and Welfare, to occupy and use the land, buildings, and improvements at Midway Park Site, Brewster Street School Site, and Stone Street Site for construction of school buildings and appurtenances, maintenance and operation of same, together with maintenance and operation of school buildings and appurtenances previously constructed.

- (1) Midway Park Site (1.58 acres)
  - (a) Building #4003 - built by funds provided by the Commissioner of Education and Federal Works Administration.
  - (b) Building #4016 - consists of 3 quonset huts, cost \$7,650.00. (Classrooms) (Year built 1944).
  - (c) Building #4021 - built by Health, Education, and Welfare.
- (2) Brewster Street School Site (30.16 acres)
  - (a) Building #40 - built 1943 under original contract for base, NOy 7122, cost \$327,992.00. (School)
