A 23" hole was drilled 23' from ground level to hard shell rock. An 18" diameter pit casing 23' long was set on the rock and fixed by filling the annular space with Portland cement.

A 172" diameter hole was drilled below the casing to a depth of 66' to a blue clay formation. The portion below the pit casing was hydraulically underreamed. After underreaming and cleaning out, an 8" diameter pump casing, consisting of 46' 7" of blank pipe to which was welded a twenty foot section of silicon bronze shutter screen, was installed. The bottom was fixed in place by a coment plug. The space between the 8" casing and the limits of the underreaming was filled with Cape May Gravel, using about eight cubic yards.

Static Water Level:

The static water level was 9' 3" below ground level.

Tests:

The well was pumped for eighteen hours and showed a constant flew of 55 g.p.m. with a drawdown of 351 7" below static level.

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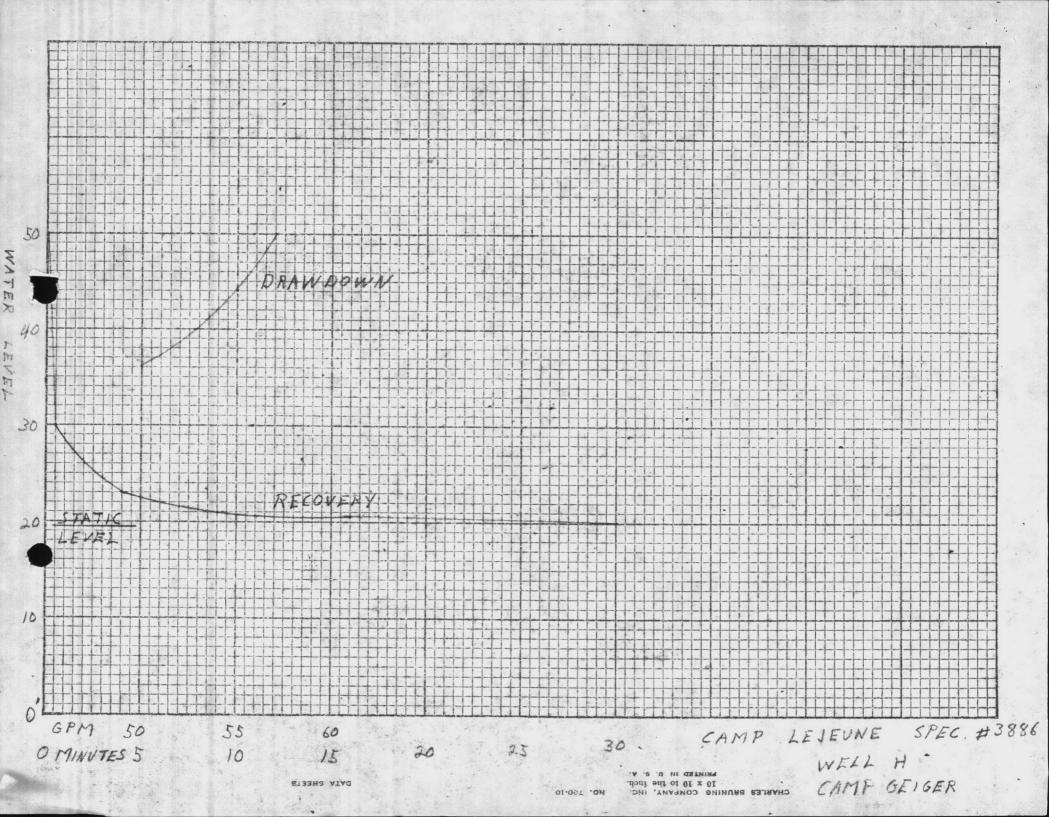

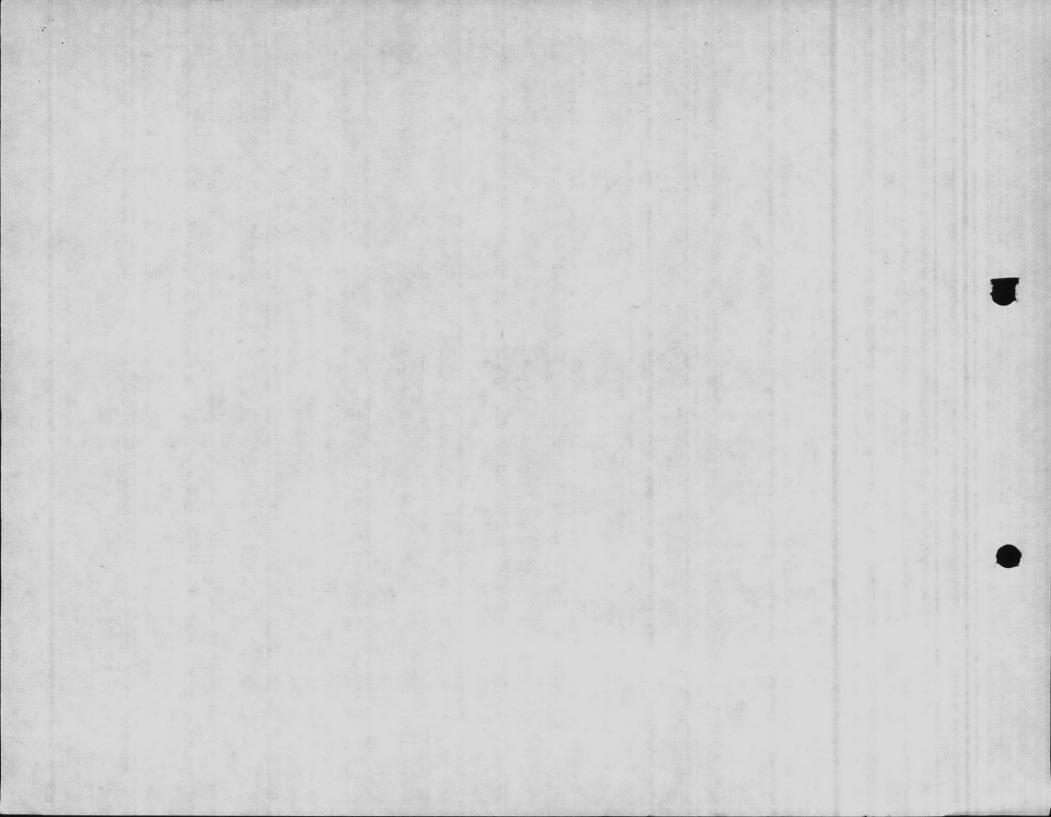
