(1) House of Representatives Report 100-209, Military Construction Appropriation Bill 1988. "The Committee regrets it has denied a barracks projects. However, such projects should be funded under the FIP and the Committee urges the Department to seek funding for this project through the FIP program." HQMC understands that this requirement has already been identified to be accomplished by the JFIP.

(2) Senate Report 100-57, National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Years 1988 and 1989. "Committee Action--Defer some overseas projects which could be financed by host nations if expanded host nation support agreements were negotiated." Excerpt from the Committee of Conference, House and Senate Appropriations Committee, Report 100-498. "Alternative Funding sources for Overseas Projects--The conference directs that future budget requests include an eligibility certification for each project in Europe, Japan, and Korea. In some cases the services have been reluctant to await financing for projects that qualify for funding and have chosen to request funding in the military construction program. For this reason, the certification will also state the current status of each project under the NATO Infrastructure, the Japanese Facilities Improvement Program, or the Korean Combined Defense Improvement Program." In light of this guidance, this project will be resubmitted for Congressional approval as soon as we have complied with the previously mentioned criteria.

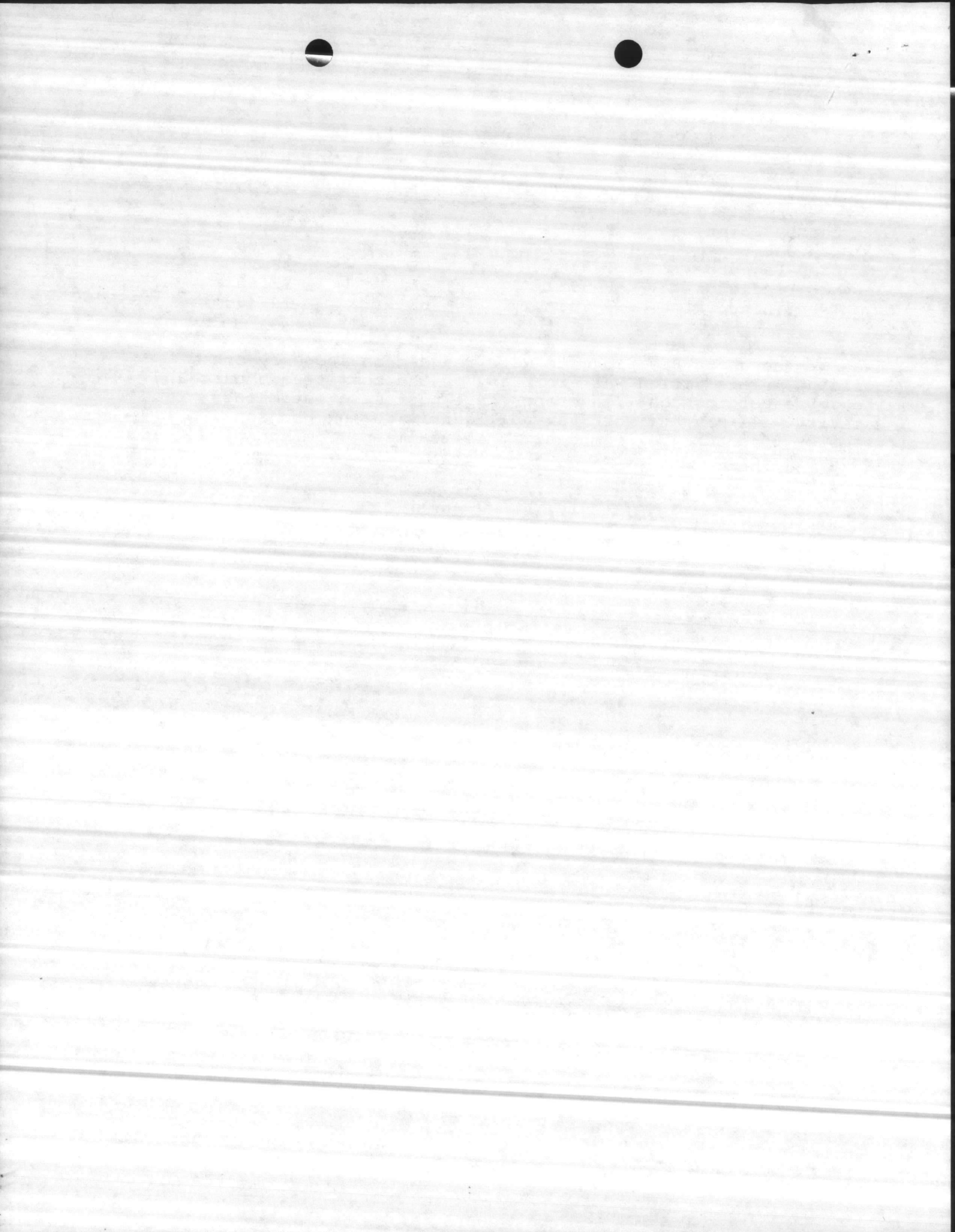
