

- 1. The Chief of Naval Operations now requires a 24-hour emergency telephone number on all Navy hazardous waste (HW) manifests. The next revision of the reference will place this requirement on Marine Corps activities. This letter formally establishes procedures for implementing this requirement. These procedures apply to shipments of HW originating within the Camp Lejeune complex. At present, HW shipments are initiated only by the Traffic Management Officer (TMO), Marine Corps Base, or the Defense Reutilization and Marketing Officer (DRMO), Camp Lejeune.
- 2. All HW manifests will show the work phone of the TMO or DRMO as the primary telephone number. The manifest will also show the emergency number (919-451-3333) of the Base Fire Department Dispatcher for use in case of no answer at the primary number. In addition, the Fire Department Dispatcher will be furnished a copy of each HW manifest on the day that the shipment leaves the activity. The enclosure shows steps to be taken by the Fire Department Dispatcher upon receipt of an emergency call from the subject transporters. 
