

The reference assigns responsibilities to the Assistant Chief of Staff, Manpower to implement the Hazardous Material Information System to provide safety data and related technical support to HMDCs, HMDOs and other cognizant officials. Based on the fact these responsibilities would be assigned to the Safety Officer, whose duties and requirements already exceed capabilities, it would be totally impractical to assign additional responsibilities without accompanying supporting manpower resources.
