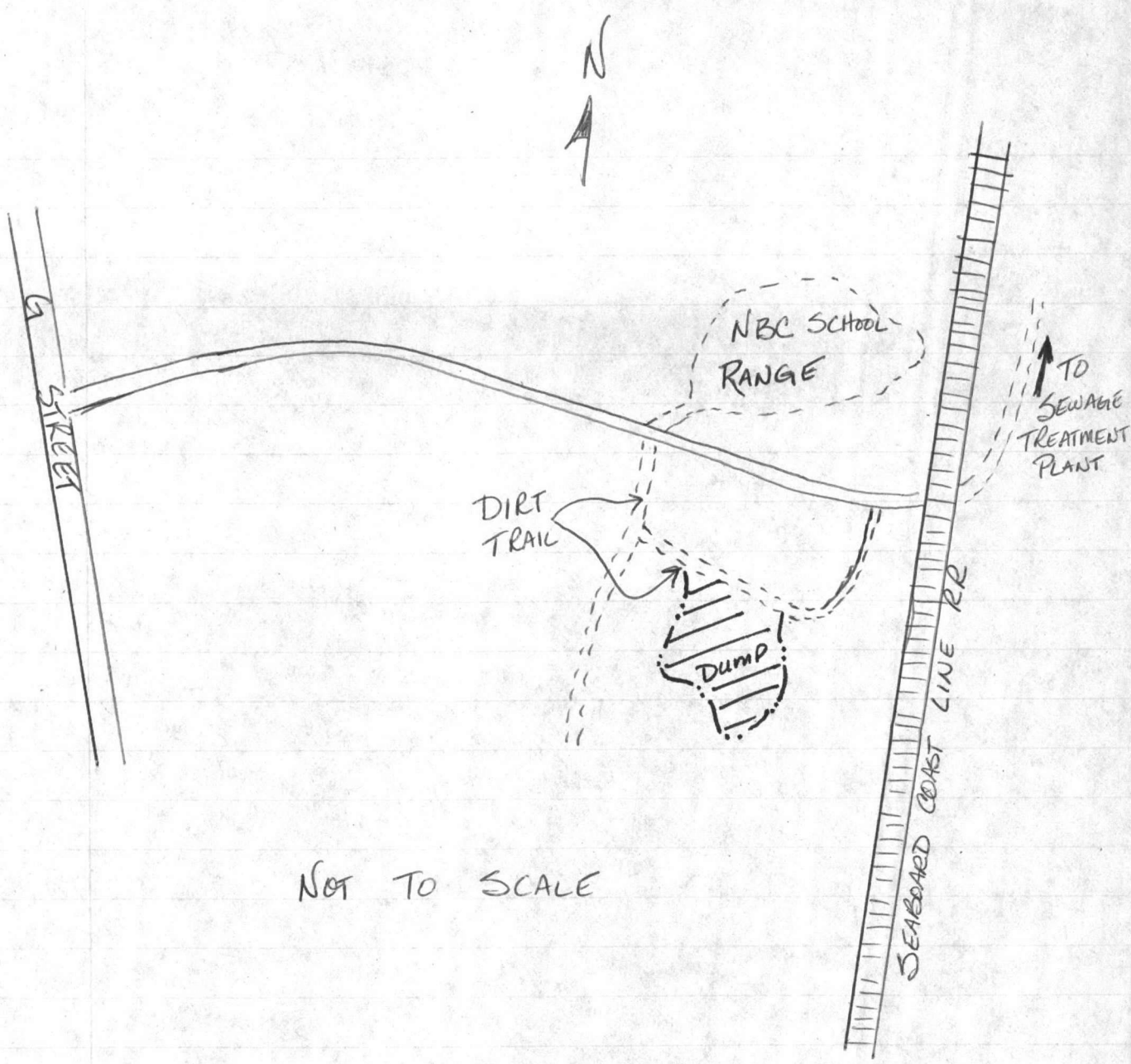
1. The subject site was reported on 25 May 1983 to Director, NREAD, by Mr. Martin, Base Fire Department.
2. During the reference, it was determined that an approximately 200-foot long, 200-foot wide grassed area has been utilized for the disposal of building demolition debris and assorted rubbish. Appearance indicates that the discarded materials were generated during demolition and/or renovation of a MCB building in the general vicinity.
3. Approximately 90 percent of the deposited material consists of wooden debris, including lumber, utility poles, crates, windows, doors, and pallets. Other debris includes bagged leaves, chairs, mattresses, metal bathroom stalls, and assorted empty fluid containers. The following discarded chemicals were identified:
 - (1) 1 gallon of "Eversal" walking compound
 - (2) Approximately 2 gallons of lube oil - ACFT Piston Engine
 - (3) Approximately 0.5 gallon of 2-Propanol



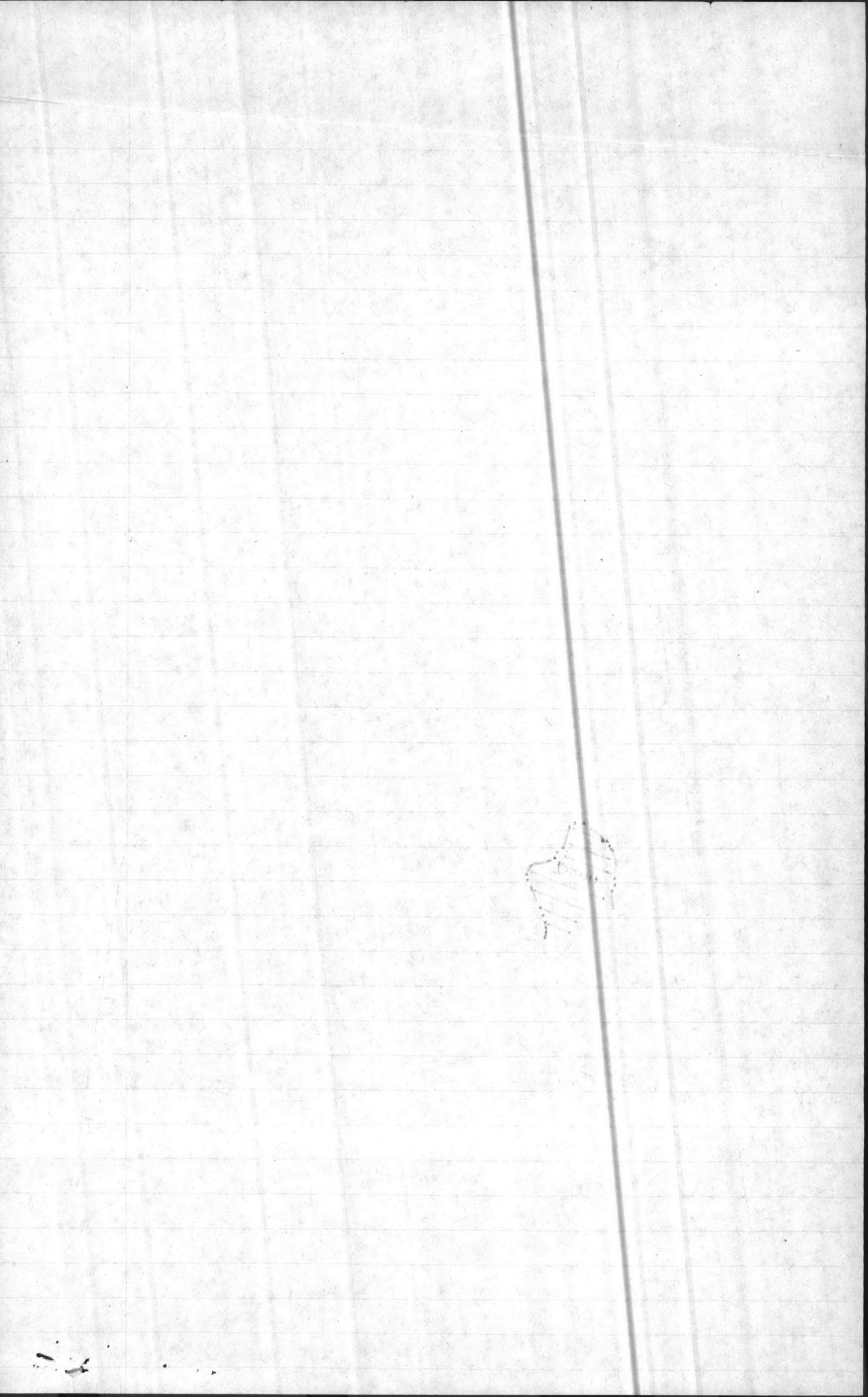
4. On 23 June 1983 at 0845 I contacted Sgt. Thompson, Camp Geiger Executive Office, concerning the dumping activity. Sgt. Thompson referred me to Staff Sgt. Helpsley, Camp Geiger Property, ^(DCA) who was aware of the dump but claimed that the facility (dump) was authorized. I informed him that the illegal dump was a violation of State Statutes and that the material must be removed to the MCB Sanitary Landfill. ^{Helpsley} Thompson stated that he did not have manpower or facilities to remove the material in a timely fashion, and asked who to contact. I suggested that he follow his normal procedural route to request assistance from Base Maintenance, but I clearly stated that I was not obligating Base Maintenance in any way. Sgt. ~~Thompson~~ ^{Helpsley} is to contact this office when the cleanup is completed.

1. During reference (a), it was determined that no refuse had been removed from the dump site as NREAD recommended. During reference (b), Lt. Goehring was briefed on the situation and advised that all materials should be removed to the Base Sanitary Landfill as soon as possible. Lt. Goehring was also notified that the materials could not be burned. Lt. Goehring stated that he had a manpower problem - told him to contact his chain of command to request help. Goehring to call NREAD and report status.

2. During reference (c) it was determined that no solid waste had been removed from the subject dumpsite.
