1. As agreed in references (a) through (c), a draft revised Annual Report for MCAS(H), NR is enclosed for forwarding to the State of North Carolina. Per reference (b), the compounds which are reported must include those wastes listed in enclosure (1) to reference (c), which is the list of pre-determined hazardous wastes as agreed by DoD and Defense Logistics Agency. These compounds will be reported as hazardous waste even though potential exists for recovery/recycling through the DPDO.

2. The possibility of the MCAS(H), NR dropping the registration as a Hazardous Waste Generator was discussed in references (a) and (b). Per reference (b), the State would agree to consolidate Hazardous Waste Management under one facility identification number and Part B permit for the Camp Lejeune complex. The State staff understands that storage and transportation capabilities are provided by Camp Lejeune with assistance of MCAS(H), NR and DPDO. Therefore, we recommend that a request be forwarded to the state to delete MCAS(H), NR as a Hazardous Waste Generator.

3. The assistance in Hazardous Waste Management currently provided by the MCAS(H), NR should continue in order to assure adequate control, record-keeping and safe handling of regulated compounds. Designation of the S-4, MCAS(H), NR as the Hazardous Material Disposal Coordinator, per reference (c), is recommended.
