

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


In response to your request for assistance in selecting safety 1. equipment, a meeting with the Base Fire Chief was conducted to discuss needs and available equipment. In addition to this meeting, trade journals and NFPA Codes were researched. Following is a list of personal protective equipment that should be made available to NREAD orest firefighting personnel: a. Head protection (hard hats) b. Safety toe footwear c. Eye protection d. Flame resistant coveralls e. Escape hood, with particulate filter f. Fire shelter f. Fire shelter

- g. Water (for consumption)
- h. Radio

In addition to the above items, radio communication capabilities with 2. State Fire Service personnel is crucial to the safety of NREAD firefighters When conducting joint NREAD/State operations.
