

Dear Mr. Bond:

Please be advised that the City of Jacksonville has been unable to obtain a grant-of-easement on the northeast side of Brinson Creek covering the construction of the referenced water line. Additionally, detailed hydraulic computations have been made and there is not adequate water pressure in the military water distribution system to supply water the distance required.

It is our desire to continue studying the possibility of constructing the referenced water line at some future date. However, until other possibilities have been investigated, we must hold the project at its present status.

Please accept my thanks and appreciation for your cooperation and assistance in this matter.




Subj: Request for Easement by City of Jacksonville, North Carolina







- 1. The City of Jacksonville, North Carolina has requested a pipeline easement over government property at the Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune for construction of a water pipeline. The general location of the proposed easement is shown on enclosure (1). The easement is shown in detail on enclosures (2) and (3). By reference (a), Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune and the Commandant of the Marine Corps approved granting of the easement.
- 2. Since the real property involved is the only property which can reasonably be used for the intended purpose, it is proposed that an easement be granted to the City of Jacksonville in accordance with Statutory Authority of Title 10, U. S. Code, Section 2669. The easement will be for a period of 50 years and will incorporate the provisions contained in the government's standard pipeline easement form, Exhibit "C" to NAVFAC P-73, Section 21.
- 3. The City pipeline will connect with the Base's water supply system in the Camp Geiger area. The purpose of the connection is to provide the City of Jacksonville with a back-up source of water supply in the event of an emergency resulting in the City's loss of water supply from its own sources. This will be a reciprocal situation wherein Camp Lejeune will use the City's water supply in the event of an emergency within the base's supply system. As stated above, this has been approved by Camp Lejeune and the Commandant of the Marine Corps. Explicit details of the arrangement will be worked out between the City and Camp Lejeune. All expenses related to installation, maintenance, and use of the pipeline will be absorbed by the City. Construction of the pipeline will be subject to prior government approval of the plans and specifications.



- 4. Since the government will derive benefits exceeding the value of the easement through the back-up source of potable water, it is proposed that the easement be granted without monetary consideration.
- 5. As required by NAVFAC P-73, Section 21, it is hereby determined that an easement is the most appropriate interest for the purpose; that the easement will not materially interfere with the government's present or foreseeable use of the property or with other government activities in the vicinity; that the government has sufficient jurisdiction thereover to grant the requested easement; that the property is not encumbered by other rights which would be incompatible with the proposed use; and that the City of Jacksonville has the capacity to acquire the easement and to comply with the terms thereover.
- 6. The addressees' concurrences in the granting of the proposed easement is requested. Commandant Fifth Naval District/Commander, Naval Base, Norfolk comments and recommendations should be forwarded to the Commander, Naval Facilities Engineering Command. Concurrence will be presumed unless advice to the contrary is received within 30 days.







Dear Mr. Wray:

Your letter of 29 November 1972, addressed to the Commanding General, Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune, concerning the City's proposed use of government property at Camp Lejeune for the construction of a water pipeline, has been referred to this command as a matter under our cognizance. We are now in the process of obtaining higher approvals for granting of the requested easement.

Upon reviewing the drawings forwarded by your letter, we note that the easement survey data is shown on two different drawings. Neither drawing shows sufficient information to allow use of the drawing as an easement exhibit. It would be appreciated, therefore, if you would furnish us with a survey drawing showing all metes and bounds data for the proposed easement. Ten copies are required.

Upon receipt of all requisite approvals, a draft of the proposed easement will be forwarded for your review. The easement will specify that the City's plans and specifications must be submitted for government approval prior to commencement of construction. Four sets of the plans and specifications are required. The plans and specifications should show all details of the pipeline construction; particularly the Brinson Creek crossing. The easement will also include a provision requiring periodical flushing of the line. This will necessitate the inclusion of a suitable flushing device in the City's line at the point of connection with the government's line. The plans and specifications should, therefore, include such a device.

Concerning the easement width (20') as shown on Drawing Number C-1972-1018-1; our regulations prohibit the inclusion of more land in the easement area than is necessary for the intended purpose. Please review and verify your requirement in this regard.
