


- 1. The enclosure explains that a need exists for a 2" PVC sewage force main with a 6" steel casing pipe to be bored under the Camp Legeune Railroad and Right of way for the purpose of serving a civilian restaurant/lounge and grocery store nearby with C. B. W. Utilities handling the sewage at their treatment plant. The enclosure also contains a request for permission from the Government to allow the force main to be bored under the Government trackage and for an easement to be granted to C. B. W. Utilities to cover this force main.
- 2. Pursuant to the request as contained in the enclosure, it is requested that exhibits "A, "B" and "C", attached to the enclosure, be reviewed for completeness and compliance with regulations and, if satisfactory, that an easement be executed for the sewage force main to be bored under the Government trackage.



Dear Sir:

On behalf of C.B.W. Utilities, Inc. of Onslow County, the following letter and sketches detail our request to bore under the railroad with a sewage force main to serve The Bull Restaurant and Lounge.

The Bull Restaurant and Lounge presently tries to handle its sewage disposal by means of septic tank and drainfield. However, they are having extreme problems with this method and have been warned that they will be closed down if they do not solve the problem. C.B.W. Utilities, Inc. of Onslow County, have an existing sewage treatment plant in the near area and are willing to accept sewage flow to serve The Bull. Pollard's IGA is also having problems with its septic tank and drainfield and also wants to pump it's waste to the existing treatment plant.

We are proposing to design a pumping station for The Bull Restaurant, and by means of a 2-inch sewage force main, pump the sewage to Pollard's proposed pumping station. To reach Pollard's pumping station, we are proposing to bore the railroad tracks using a steel casing as shown in the typical sketch "Exhibit C". Also enclosed are "Exhibits A and B" showing a vicinity sketch and the overall preliminary construction plan respectively. The exact design and locations of the pumping stations and the bore have yet to be determined.

Please accept this letter and these sketches as an offical request for an easement from the U.S. Marine Corps to C.B.W. Utilities, Inc. to bore the railroad. Upon completion of final design and drawings a set of plans and specifications will be submitted to you if needed.

Our client has recieved a temporary Pump and Haul Permit from the Division of Environmental Managment which expires August 31, 1986 and therefore is very anxious to get this approved as soon as possible. So he can begin construction. If you would give us preliminary approval, then we could begin construction while we finalize all paperwork with you. Please advise us of any other requirements you may have in order to obtain this agreement.

Dear Sir:

On July 3, 1986, I submitted, on behalf of C.W.B. Utilities, Inc., a request to cross the U.S.M.C. Railroad 215 foot right-of-way. Since that time, I have had several correspondences with the Real Estate Division, Department of Navy, in Norfolk, Virginia. In the meantime, C.W.B. Utilities, Inc. has had a difficult time with the parties involved in this project. As of now, The Bull Restaurant and Lounge does not intend to construct the previously proposed facilities. Also, we have been unable to obtain the necessary easement from Mr. Gregory to cross his land. Therefore on behalf of C.W.B. Utilities, Inc., I am requesting a 10 foot utility easement be granted from you to C.W.B. Utilities, Inc. to run the proposed sewage force main just inside the railroad right-of-way in order to go around Mr. Gregory's property.

I have discussed this with Mr. Lee Warren of the Real Estate Division, in Norfolk, Virginia, and per his instructions I am forwarding to you for your review a sketch showing the changes to the original request, a survey map, and a centerline description of the requested easement.

Also, as Pollard's IGA grocery store is under considerable pressure to build this system, having been threatened to be closed down by the local health department, we are requesting that permission be given to temporarily build this sewer line, above ground, if necessary, to relieve Pollard's IGA of its sewage disposal problem. We understand that if we build this, then the easement is denied, we would have to remove it and restore the site to its original condition.

Portion of the U.S.M.C. Railroad Right-of-way White Oak Township, Onslow County, North Carolina

Being a proposed 10 foot utility easement lying along, parallel to and extending 5 feet on either side of the proposed centerline being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the Southern right-of-way line of U.S.M.C. Railroad (215 foot right-of-way), said point being located North 74 degrees 27 minutes 40 seconds 7.07 feet from an existing concrete monument on said right-of-way line, said monument being the Northeasternmost corner of that property described in Deed Book 575, Page 52 of the Onslow County Registry, said monument being located South 13 degrees 24 minutes 10 seconds West 56.71 feet from a new railroad spike in the centerline of the tracks of the U.S.M.C. railroad, said spike being located as measured along the centerline of said tracks, 502.85 feet from a new P.K. nail at the point of intersection of the centerline of said tracks with the approximate centerline of Piney Green Road (NCSR 1406 60 foot right-of-way); thence from the above described point of beginning and leaving the aforementioned Southern right-of-way line, North 60 degrees 32 minutes 20 seconds West 7.07 feet to a point; thence South 74 degrees 27 minutes 40 seconds West 290.17 feet to a point; thence South 29 degrees 27 minutes 40 seconds West 7.07 feet to the point of intersection of the centerline of the proposed easement with the Southern right-of-way line of the U.S.M.C railroad right-of-way, said
