


1. <u>Purpose</u>. To disseminate format and instructions for preparation of requirements lists for Classes 3 and 4 Plant Property Investment Items.

2. <u>Background</u>. Reference (a) prescribes that requirements for Classes 3 and 4 plant property investment-type items for Fiscal Years 1978-1979 be submitted separately to Headquarters, Marine Corps by 1 March 1977. Classes 3 and 4 plant property investment type items are those items with an acquisition cost of \$1,000 or more which are funded by appropriation Procurement, Marine Corps funds. Exceptions to the \$1,000 rule are (1) special services equipment with a primary use in connection with the special services program, (2) food preparation and serving equipment except for the following items which are movable in nature, but are classified as investment-type items: drinking water coolers, waste disposals (such as incinerators), dishwashers, hoods and vents (to which the \$1,000 expense/investment cost criteria applies). All other items of food service equipment are considered expense-type items, regardless of acquisition cost, and will be included in the Base Expense Operating Budget.

3. Action

a. Fund Administrators/Supply/Responsible Officers concerned with plant property are requested to submi⁺ via their normal chain of command requirements for Classes 3 and 4 plant property investment-type items for Fiscal Years 1978-79 in the format shown in enclosure (1). Enclosure (2) contains detailed instructions for the preparation of the requirements lists and enclosure (3) contains a listing of major items within the functional groups.

b. When determining requirements, consideration should be given to the age and condition of present equipment. Which may require replacement

during Fiscal Year 1978/79 as well as to planned procurement of additional equipment. It should be noted that the acquisition cost of plant account fistings is probably insufficient to cover replacement cost at the present time; therefore, since Procurement, Marine Corps funds are provided in accordance with costs shown on the budget submission, current prices and not those shown on the plant account listing should be used. Current prices may be obtained by contacting T&R, Base Materiel Battalion and/or the Purchasing and Contracting Division, Base Materiel Battalion and giving a complete description of the item(s) desired.


c. Requirements list submission should be as complete as possible in that supplementary requests for Procurement, Marine Corps funds, received subsequent to budget submissions, must be held to an absolute minimum.

d. Separate Detail List for Classes 3 and 4 plant property will be submitted to this Headquarters (Attention: Assistant Chief of Staff, Supply Services) in triplicate for Fiscal Years 1978 and 1979. Requirements reports received after 14 January 1977 will not be considered in this budget cycle. Negative reports are requested.

e. Copy to addressees are requested to assure that units under their cognizance submit their PMC requirements via the normal chain of command.



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



PERSONAL CAPITAL PLANT EQUIPMENT (INVESTMENT-TYPE ITEMS) WITH A UNIT COST OF \$1,000 OR MORE

1. Fund Administrators/Supply/Responsible Officers will prepare separate Detail Lists (enclosure (1)) for Fiscal Year 1978 and Fiscal Year 1979. Detailed lists shall be broken down into functional groups. Each item on the detailed list will be supported by brief justification, e.g., age, condition, excessive maintenance costs, parts problems, replacement versus repair, modernization, new requirement implications, increases in personnel table of organization, training, condition code or age alone is not sufficient and should be supported by economic aspects. This justification should also reflect the primary utilization of the equipment and in which organization (function) it is used. Items required for Equipment Installation or Urgent Minor Construction Projects should be indicated. Refer to enclosure (3) for determination of major items within functional groups of the detailed list.

2. Do not include food preparation and serving equipment unless identified in paragraph 2 of basic letter. All food preparation and serving equipment used exclusively for training purposes will be funded by Marine Corps Service Support Schools.

3. Do not include construction, railway and weight handling equipment. These are budgeted for by Headquarters, Marine Corps.

4. Do not include items submitted under separate programs, i.e., Carrison , Mobile Engineer Equipment (reference MCO 11260.3_), Nonstandard Photographic Equipment (reference MCO P3150.3_), Training Support Center Equipment (reference MCO 1551.1_), Data Processing Equipment (reference MCO 10462.4_), Special Services Equipment (reference MCO P1710.17_), T/E items (reference NAVMC 1017). Stationary items of construction or weight handling equipment or other Garrison Mobile Equipment which do not fall within the scope of the Garrison Mobile Equipment Procurement Program should be included.


5. Those plant equipment items with a unit cost of \$1,000 or more, not submitted in separate programs, will be included.

6. Do not include the value of this report within the EOB.

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7. Equipment installation will be funded as investment as a part of the procurement cost when a single contractor is providing for the equipment and installation in a single contract.


