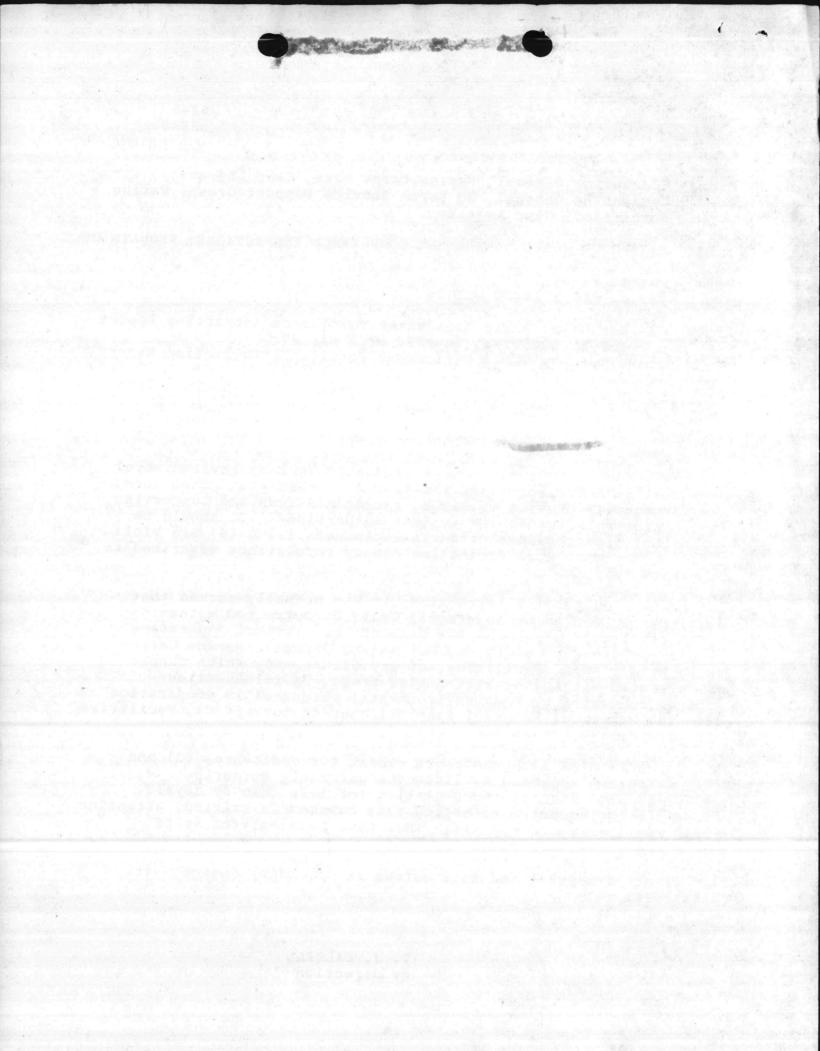

Addressee should immediately notify the Commanding General, Marine Corps Base, Attn: AC/S, Facilities, of any discrepancy which cannot be corrected within the stated time frame. A reinspection will be conducted by Base environmental personnel in cooperation with the Hazardous Material Disposal Coordinator (HMDC), Facilities and Safety, G-4, 2d FSSG.
- 3. Appendix B of each enclosure except for enclosures (2) and (3), which are appendix A, lists the currently authorized HW generation and storage (accumulation for less than 90 days). Addressee is requested to notify this command in writing, attention AC/S, Facilities, of any sites that have been omitted or if there are additional sites required.

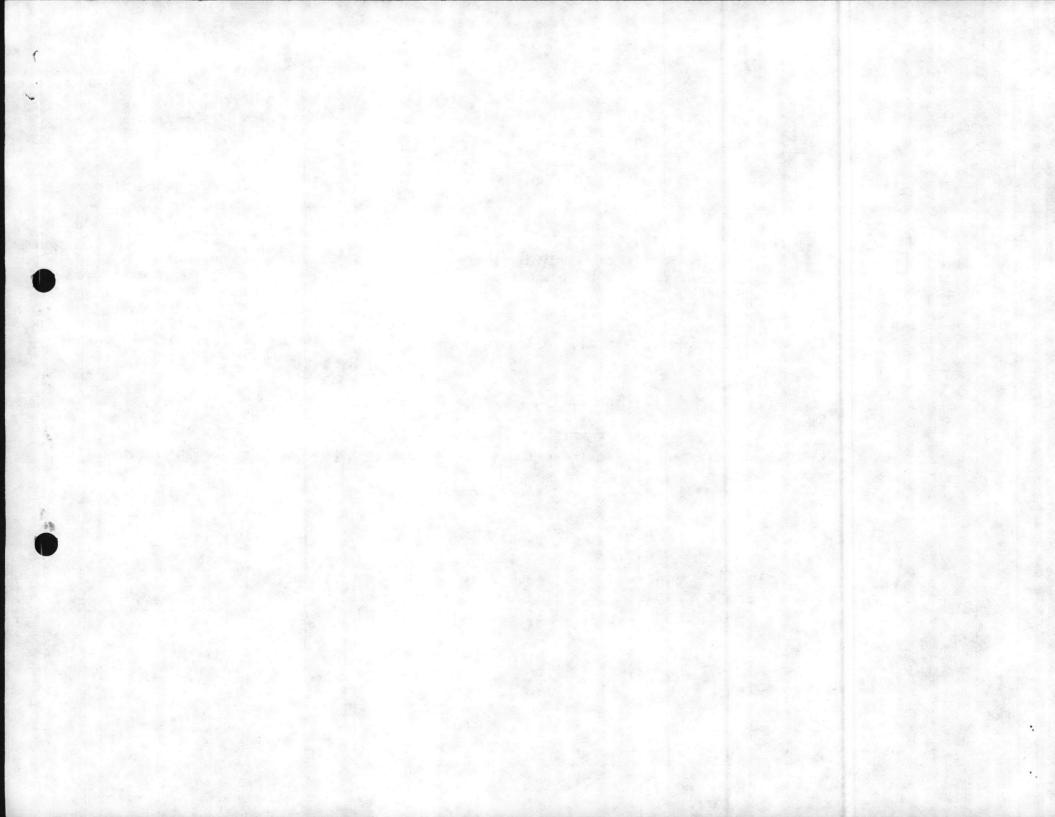

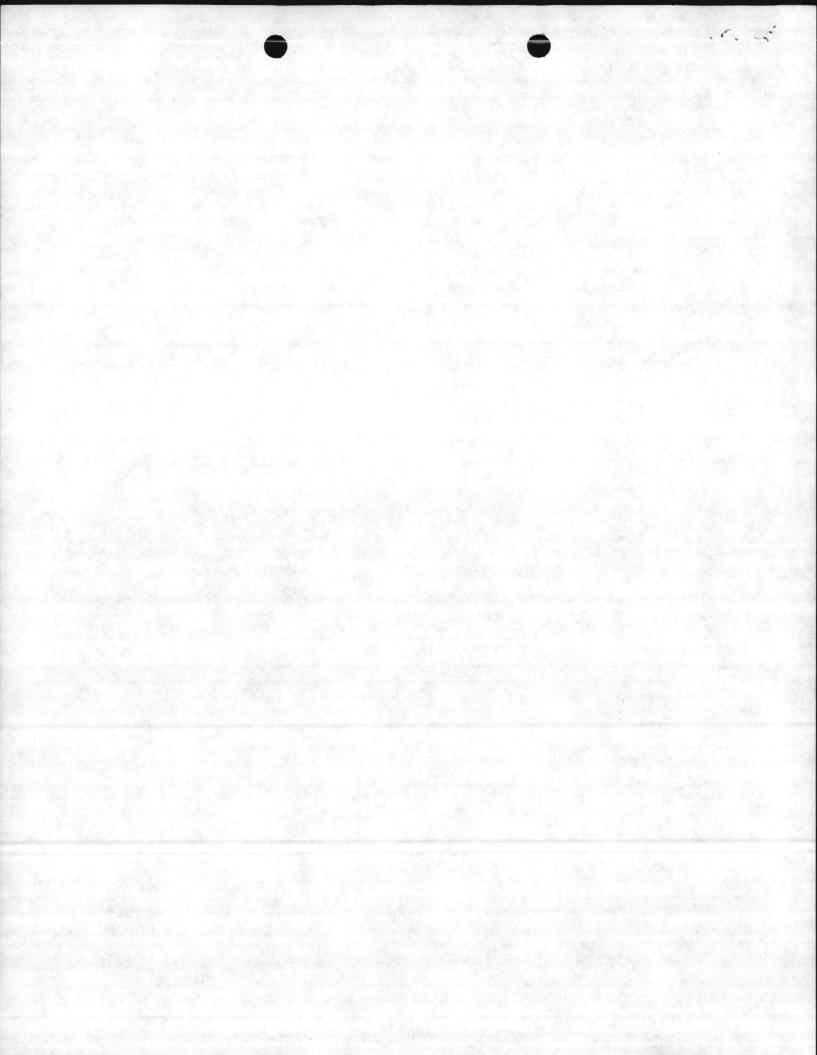

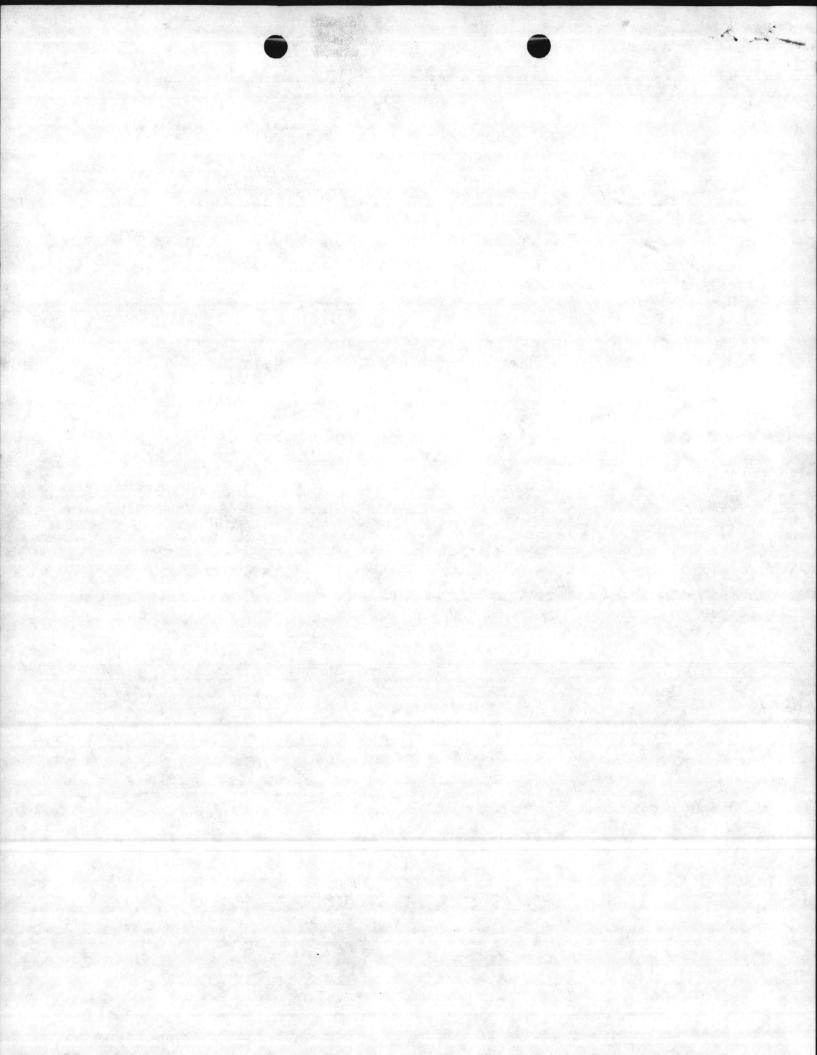
AUTHORIZED HAZARDOUS WASTE GENERATION & STORAGE SITES FOR 2d RADBN, 2d FSSG

GENERATION/ACCUMULATION

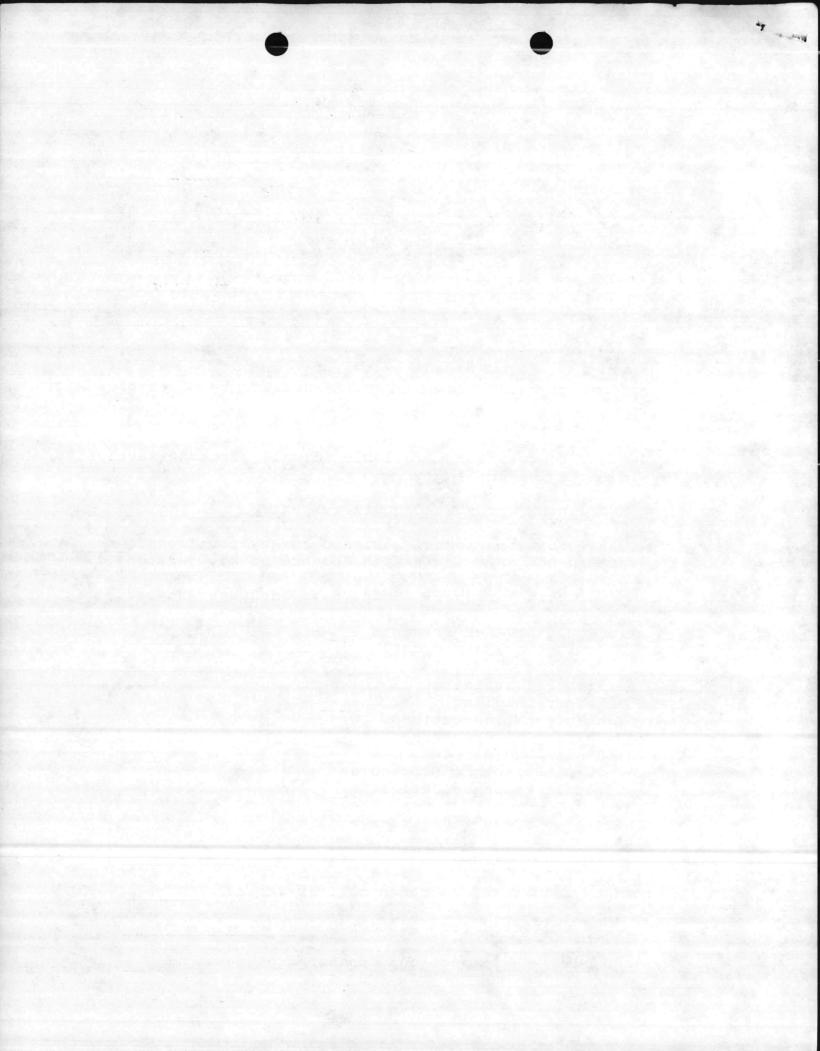

GENERATION/ACCUMULATION

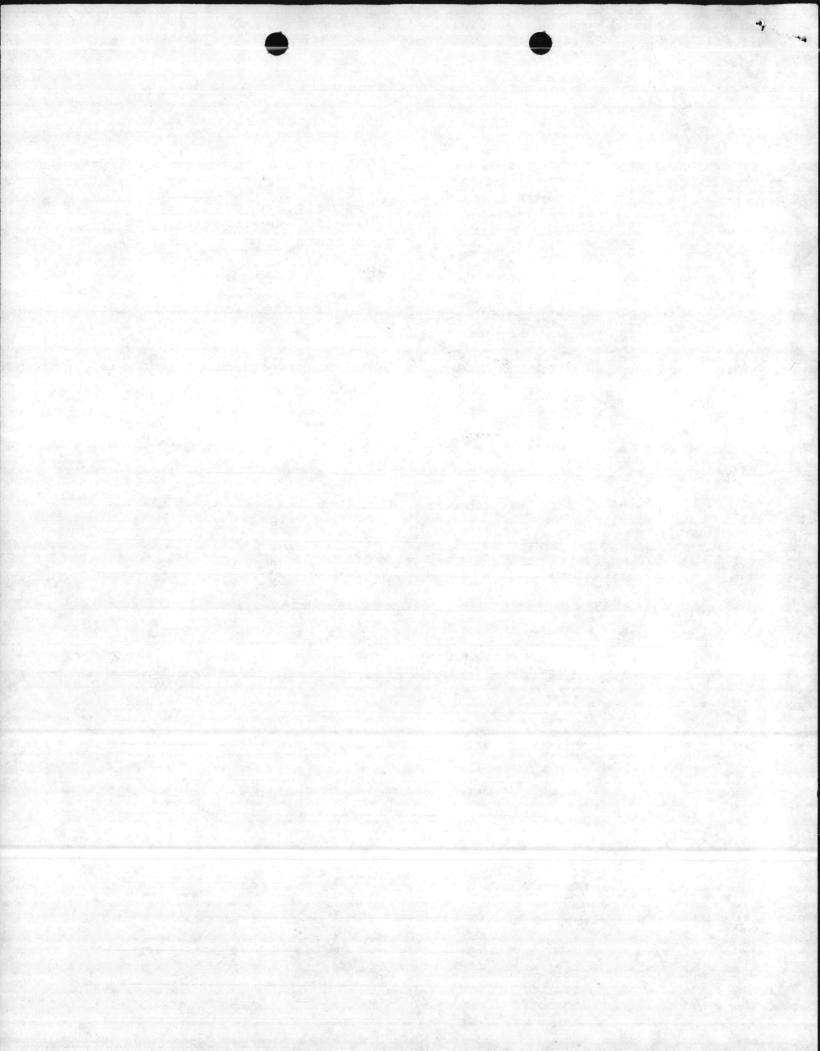
