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#### REQUIREMENTS

Commandant, FMFLANT Headquarters, Norfolk, Virginia must submit a written request for future TRUE evolutions to William H. Webster, Director, Federal Bureau of Investigation, JEH Building, 9th & Pennsylvania, Washington, D.C. A reference should be made to the previous TRUE evolution provided by the New York Office.

In advance of the request, 2nd Force Reconnaissance Company will establish liaison with New York and conduct preplanning.

2nd Force Reconnaissance Company must send an "advance party" to arrive at least four working days ahead of the main body's arrival. Specific point of contacts and liaisons will be transferred from the FBI over to 2nd Force Reconnaissance Company personnel.

No consolidated mess facility exists on Stewart Army Subpost. The per diem rate in the Newburgh, New York area is a high rate. Marine personnel on TAD orders should receive more than the \$13.00 per day per diem rate inasmuch as this was insufficient to cover food costs.



#### TRANSPORTATION


Rental vehicles were secured from Thrifty Rent-A-Car, 149 W. 49th Street, New York, New York, 212-239-1320. A rental contract was signed for each vehicle and one set of TAD orders were required for release to the driver.

Vehicles were mid size and of the four door variety in order to facilitate loading/unloading. Sedans were procured to maintain overall security of the TRUE training.

During the training, one vehicle developed mechanical problems and subsequently replaced. All vehicles were overloaded due to personnel and large amounts of equipment. All vehicles provided safe and reliable service except as noted above and were returned to vendor, 9/27/85.

It is being noted for purposes of operational security that TAD orders identified as reason for movement "TACTICAL RECONNAISSANCE URBAN ENVIRONMENT." Vendor reviewed TAD orders and was inquisitive. The FBI excised that portion of the order prior to releasing a copy for contract purposes.

An advance team should secure the vehicles and relocate them at Stewart Army Subpost prior to the arrival of the main body. This will facilitate movement of personnel and equipment to/from the flight line. Advance party will return vehicles on day of departure of main body.

Transportation of 20 Marines consisted of five (5) sedan type automobiles:



- 2. 3 ea sedan automobiles

This change is necessary due to the large amounts of equipment, supplies needed at the various training locations.




#### EQUIPMENT

However, it will not be a source of constant use for TRUE training inasmuch as it must be maintained in a ready to go status should FBI operations require its use.

This equipment must be brought with 2nd Force Reconnaissance Company at each TRUE evolution. The equipment used will become a part of each unit deployed on a MAU inasmuch as training aids and techniques learned at TRUE can be conducted aboard ship.



#### AIR OPERATIONS


The primary uses of the UH-IN were the transportation of men and equipment to various training locations, familiarization flying in mountainous terrain, built up urban areas, and insertion/extraction of raid party in selected scenarios.

One of the newest insertion techniques available to 2nd Force Reconnaissance Company is FAST ROPE. Inasmuch as 2nd Force Reconnaissance Company is the only unit in the United States Marine Corps that has the hardware configured for the UH-IN as well as the deplaning ropes, FAST ROPE operations were conducted in a variety of settings.

By way of background- two GANTRY units used for FAST ROPE in the UH-1N were configured from surveyed internal rescue hoists, modified and provided by FBI New York. A complete documentation package was supplied to 2nd Force Reconnaissance Company. In addition, MCDEC, Quantico, Virginia was supplied with all documentation and research previously conducted by the FBI on the GANTRY unit. Procurement of the GANTRY unit can be expedited if Headquarters Marine Corps will initiate a letter to the U.S. Army helicopter test facility at Lake Hurst, New Jersey, attention Lt. Col. Kleiner, and task and provide modification and fabrication funding. There exists no other prudent avenue to have such units made at a cost not to exceed \$1000-\$1400 percopy!

Raid scenarios employing the use of both UH/AH helicopters provide a degree of realism and difficulty of manuever.


Immediately following is a position paper authored by R.W Spencer, CPT, HMA-269, MAG 29. CPT Spencer flew the AH-1J during the TRUE I training and offers some interesting observations from an aviators point of view. CPT Spencer flew all air routes established during the training which included dense urban (Manhattan, Staten Island, Queens, Brooklyn) areas.


