1. As requested in the reference, the following Minor Construction Projects, FY-91 are submitted.


2. a. A Range Maintenance/Service and Support office building would be required in the Land Acquisition Area. The building should be 20 feet wide by 50 feet long with electric service, telephones, men's and women's restrooms, shower stalls in each restroom, hot/ cold water, and heating/air conditioning. Estimated cost \$125,000. The building would house the Range Maintenance and Service and Support offices to provide administrative control for the personnel working the new range complex as well as the K-Range complex. The size of the building would allow for a small lunch area with vending machines.

b. A Maintenance/Service and Support workshop would be required to house a carpenter shop, welding shop, target mechanism shop, and electronic maintenance shop. The building should be 40 feet wide by 80 feet long with full electric service to include heating and air conditioning at an estimated cost of \$200,000. The building would be required to provide maintenance/support services to the new range complex and the K-Range complex.

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c. A paved area of approximately 200 by 300 feet (6,000 Sq. Ft) would be needed for the above buildings and also provide parking for range vehicles. An eight foot chain link fence would be required around the compound for security purposes. Estimated cost of paving and fencing would be \$200,000.
