This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter of June 25, 1959 requesting the U. S. Soverment to renebilitate and maintain certain drainage ditches crossing your property in the vicinity of Havelook, Berth Carolina.

The records at Comp Lajouno, Morth Carolina disclose that in daytember 1952 and in March 1953, you granted the W. S. Government eritten paredosien to improve, widen, despen, end/or construct drainese ditches over your property. In return for the banefit according to your property, it was agreed that any surface outers. Cloudes from the Severement Railroad, then under construction, known as the Camp Lajanne - Charry Foint Mailroad, endd be directed to flow through the drainage ditches located on your property.

as a result of an engineering investigation, it appears that surface waters, as received from the railroad right-of-way, have naver been sufficient to either damage or interfers with the use of your property.

For the aforesaid reasons, we regret to inform you that the meintenance and rehabilitation of the drainess ditches is not considered the responsibility of the U. S. Government.
