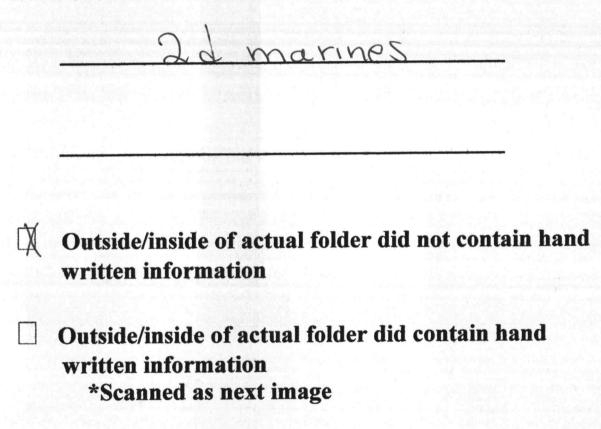

- 1. On 28 May 1987, a re-inspection was conducted by Base Environmental personnel to determine the adequacy of action taken to correct discrepancies identified during the subject inspection and documented in reference (a). The subject inspection was conducted in accordance with references (b) through (e) to determine compliance with hazardous waste regulations described in reference (f). The enclosure provides findings during the re-inspections. Required corrective action was discussed with 2D Marine Regiment personnel during the re-inspection.
- 2. Based on the enclosure and observations made during the re-inspection, the following comments are provided: (a) The level of compliance with hazardous waste regulations deteriorated since the subject inspection, and (b) in order to increase awareness to regulatory requirements, all personnel with significant hazardous waste management responsibilities should be provided formal classroom training. Base environmental personnel are available upon written request to conduct the recommended training. Addressee should arrange for training site. Classes should last approximately two hours.

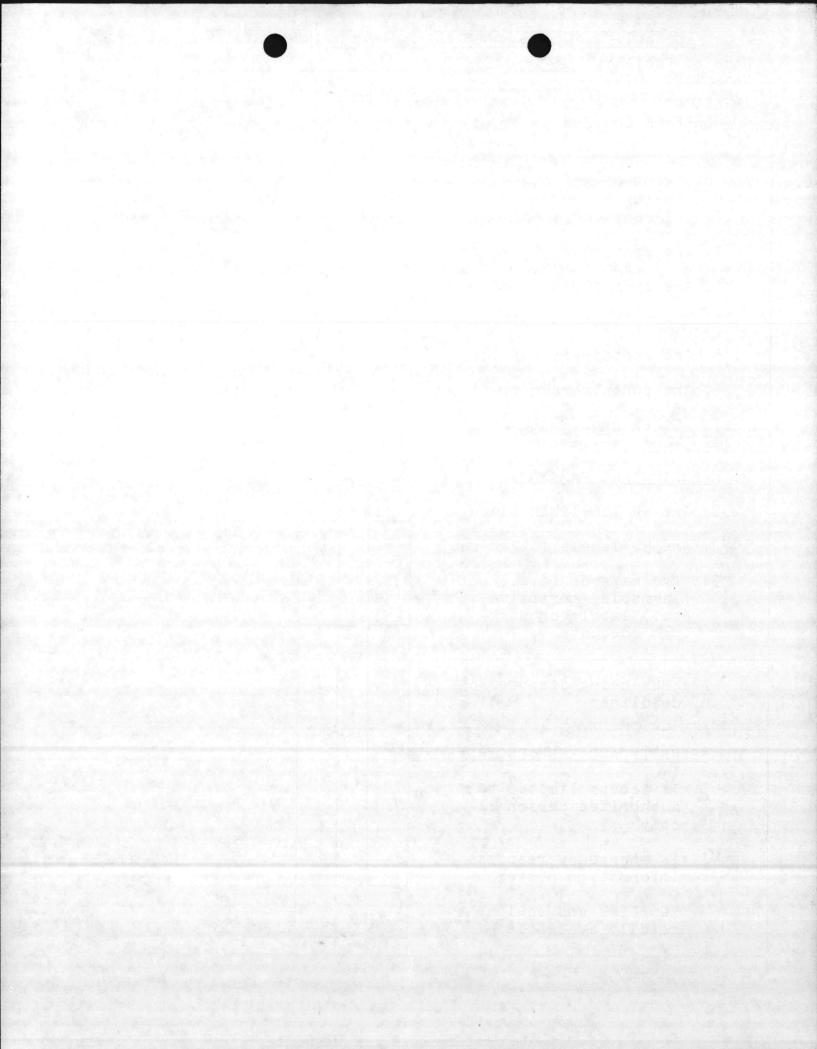
