1. The enclosure provides a series of memos written regarding issues pertaining to enforcement of the subject regulations which are outlined in the reference. Unfortunately, SJA chose to ignore the real world situation where working level officials have failed to act in good faith. Most problems are of this nature.

It is recommended that a meeting be called between NREAD, SJA representatives from various commands and Hazardous Material Disposal Coordinators to develop draft guidelines for internal enforcement of the subject regulations.



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
required. The letter will stress the requirements to adhear to the provisions of the Bose Order ond the warning of criminal and/or civil liability.
