AUTHORIZED HW GENERATION AND STORAGE SITES FOR 2d LAV BN

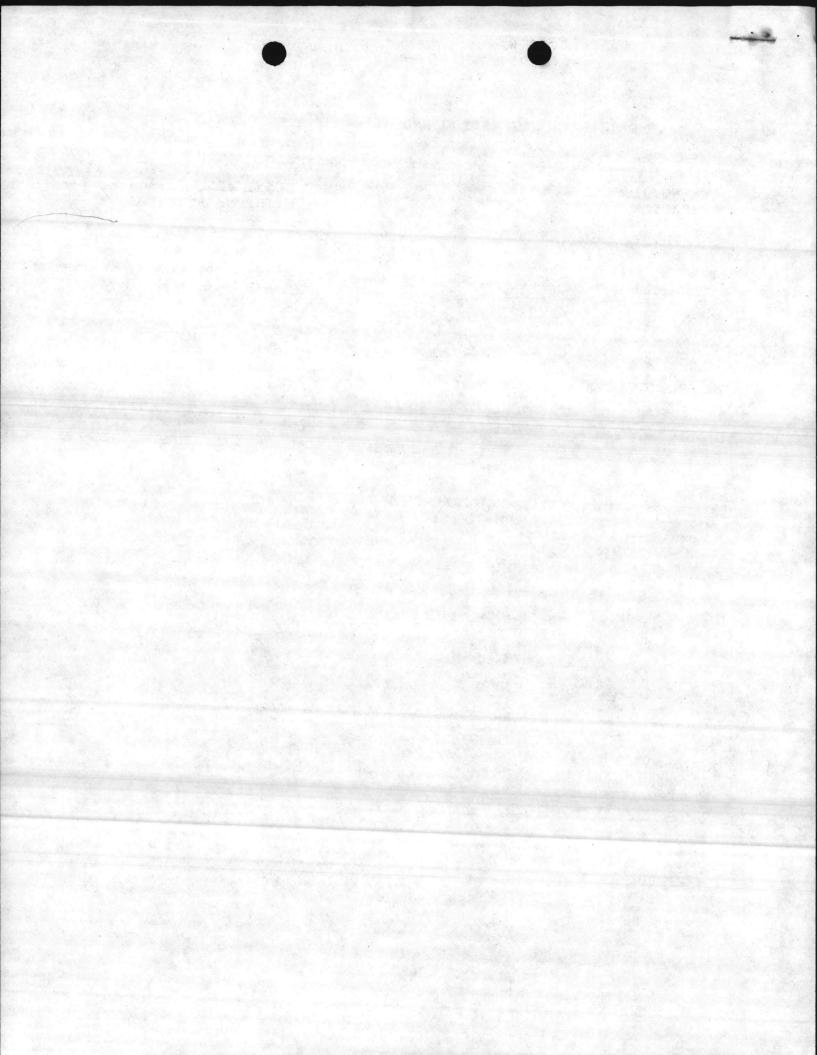
SITE NO. 1 GENERATION/ACCUMULATION
