Subj: Potentially Hazardous Products for Human Consumption

1. <u>Purpose</u>. To publish guidance and instructions relative to checking packaged items for tampering.

2. General

- a. There have been incidents of persons tampering with various nonprescription drugs and food products.
- b. Whenever products for human consumption, sold by the Exchange, appear to be tampered with (seals broken, loose tops, etc.) it will be reported to the Security/Safety Manager immediately.
- c. Depending on the product and other factors a decision will be made through liaison with the Command on an appropriate course of action.
- d. Activity managers will ensure that employees under their cognizance, particularily those involved in price marking and the stocking of shelves, are alert to the need for carefully observing containers for broken seals, etc.
- e. The Security/Safety Manager is designated as the Exchange point of contact for any hazardous products discovered.

3. Action

a. Activity managers will comply with the provisions of this Order relative to being alert for and reporting products that appear to have been tampered with.
