





all indoor type sports. The intermural sports program will consist of the following activities; Badminton, Handball, Racquetball, Weight lifting, Basketball, Volleyball, Karate, Wrestling and Boxing. This center will provide a needed diversion for the 10,000 plus personnel assigned to the 2nd FSSG forces.

CURRENT SITUATION: There is no physical fitness facility located in the newly constructed 2d FSSG complex in the French Creek Area, which is currently in support of seven (7) battalions. The Force Troops physical fitness program will be less than desired and the indoor sports program will be non-existent and impaired by overcrowded conditions existing in the nearest facility, located in the Hadnot Point Area. Morale, adequate athletic training and physical fitness program requirements for the troops as established by CMC will be deficient without such a complex.
