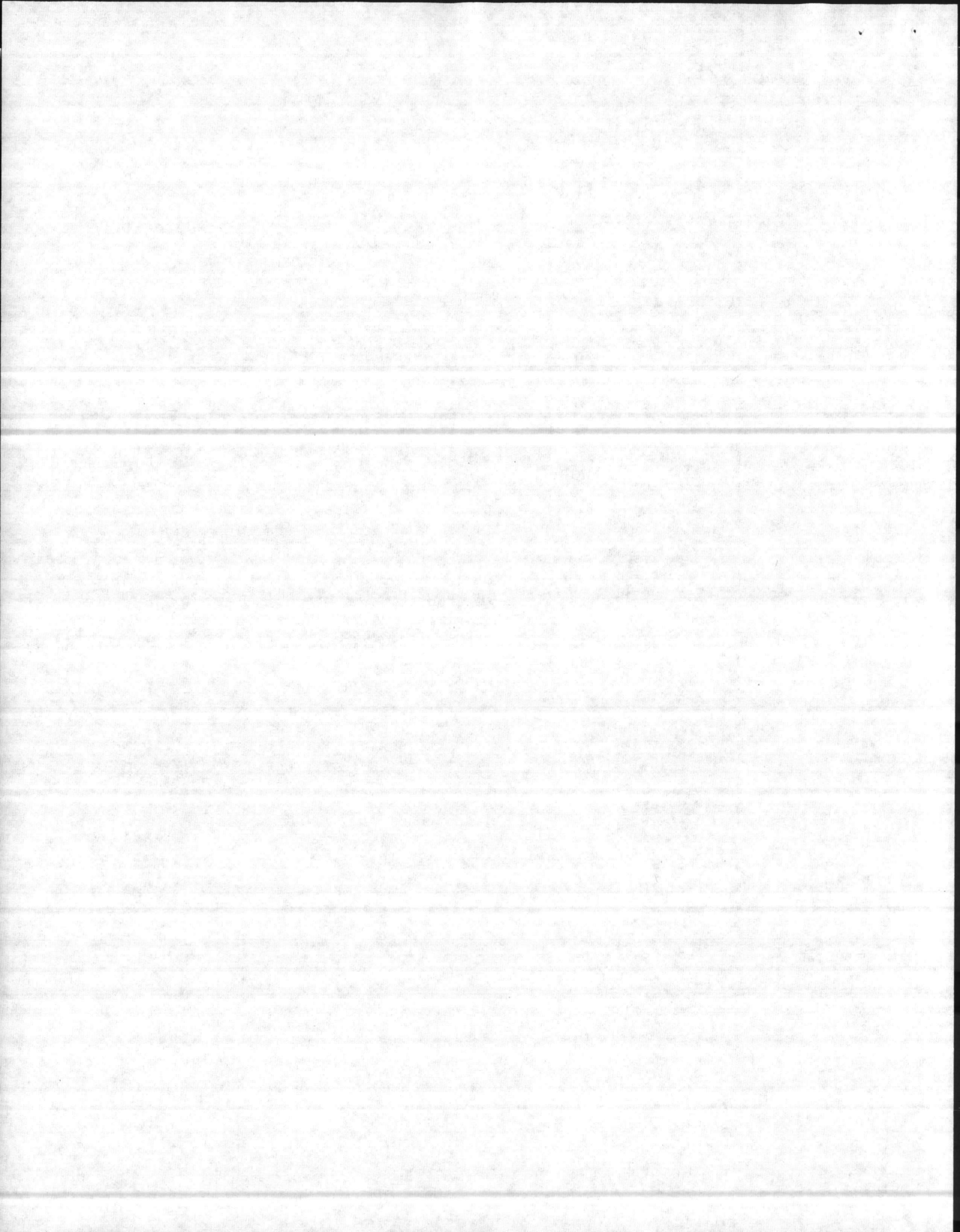

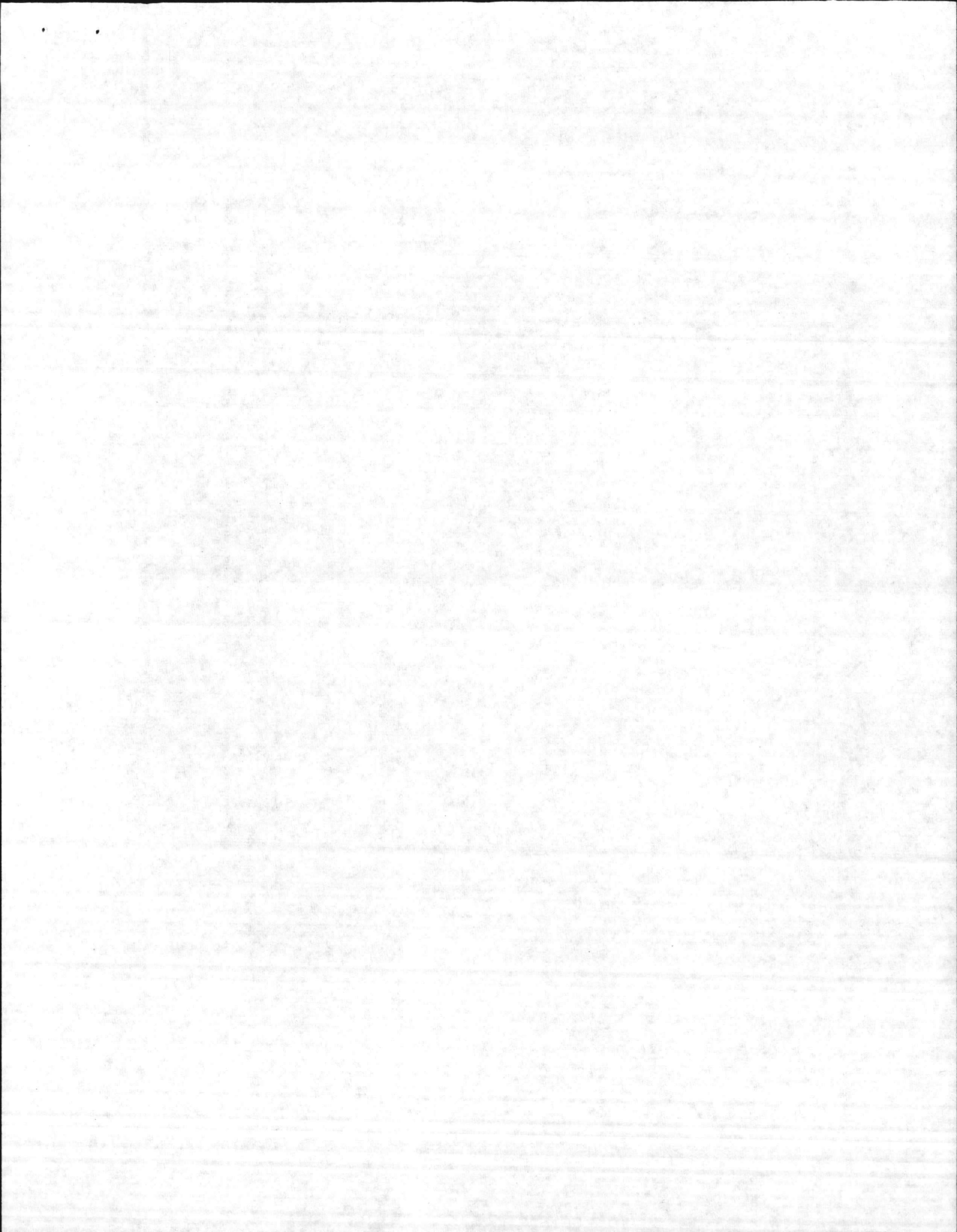

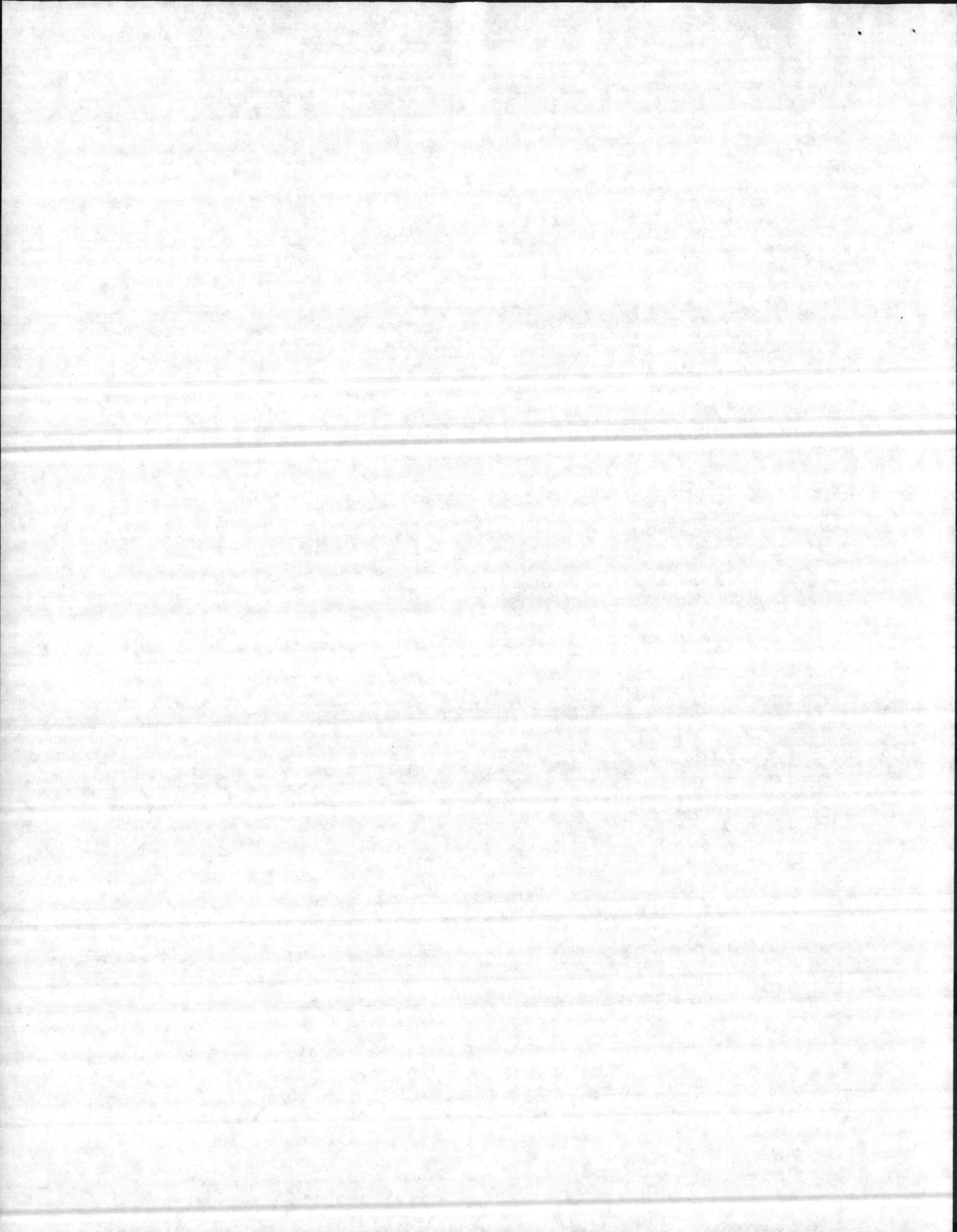

Action Compliance Requirements for Construction," and (3) its efforts to meet the goals. The hours of minority and female employment and training must be substantially uniform throughout the length of the contract, and in each trade. The Contractor shall make a good faith effort to employ minorities and women evenly on each of its projects. The transfer of minority or female employees or trainees from Contractor to Contractor, or from project to project, for the sole purpose of meeting the Contractor's goals shall be a violation of the contract, Executive Order 11246, as amended, and the regulations in 41 CFR 60-4. Compliance with the goals will be measured against the total work hours performed.

(d) The Contractor shall provide written notification to the Director, Office of Federal contract compliance Programs, within 10 working days following award of any construction subcontract in excess of \$10,000 at any tier for construction work under the contract resulting from this solicitation. The notification shall list the-

GENERAL PARAGRAPHS

1. GENERAL INTENTION: It is the declared and acknowledged intention and meaning to provide and secure the hardening of security and the installation of tiered platforms, complete and ready for use.
2. GENERAL DESCRIPTION: The work includes the installation of security screens on all windows; new exterior doors; the installation of tiered platforms in all classrooms; new finishes; the removal of asbestos insulation on pipes, attic insulation and debris in the attic, and incidental related work.
3. LOCATION: The work shall be located at the Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune, North Carolina approximately as shown. The exact location will be indicated by the Contracting Officer.
4. NOTICE OF REQUIREMENTS FOR AFFIRMATIVE ACTION TO ENSURE EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY (APR 1984)
