Subj: Letter from LANTDIV 114:WLC:mbe 6280 of 13 May 1982

- 1. The letter discusses that North Carolina has primacy for the Safe Drinking Water Act and that this command is to send all results required by Reference (d) of the letter to the State and also a capy to LANTDIV. Dt states that LANTDIV's files show some missing reports.
- 2. The required reports are outlined in Enclosure (1) of the letter. Since January 1981, we have sent the State, and LANTDIV, a monthly bacteria report.
- 3. My files do not show an organic analysis for the water plants. This sampling and analysis could have been overlooked since the Safe Drinking Water Act left the Initial sampling and frequents as a State option, for ground water. My copy of the State Regs does not call for organic analysis unless otherwise stated by the Secretary.
- 4. The inorganic analysis was done by Jennings Lab in 1979. It has to be done again this year by August. I believe LANTDIV has a copy of the results and I know the State does because we sent it last year (1981).
- 5. The radiological analysis was arranged by LANTDIV through an Army lab. It started in 1979 and does have to be done again until 1983. A copy of the results were sent to be State and LANTDIV with the inorganic analysis in 1981.
- 6. As for the Trihalomethanes, the Army lab anlysis was invalid for reporting to the State and Grammager's results have not been set yet.
