In accordance with your application received September 27, 1982, we are forwarding herewith Well Construction Permit No. 66-0135-WC-0082 dated October 7, 1982, issued to The United States Marine Corps for the construction of a 288,000 gallon per day water supply well.

If any parts, requirements, or limitations contained in this Permit are unacceptable to you, you have the right to an adjudicatory hearing before a hearing officer upon written demand to the Director within 30 days following receipt of this Permit, identifying the specific issues to be contended. Unless such demand is made, this Permit shall be final and binding.

This Permit will be effective from the date of its issuance and shall be subject to the conditions and limitations as specified therein.

PERMIT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A WELL OR WELL SYSTEM

In accordance with the provisions of Article 7, Chapter 87, North Carolina General Statutes, and other applicable Laws, Rules and Regulations.

PERMISSION IS HEREBY GRANTED TO

the United States Marine Corps

FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF a water supply well located near the main office in Tarawa Terrace I in Onslow County, in accordance with the application dated September 23, 1982 and in conformity with specifications and supporting data, all of which are filed with the Department of Natural Resources and Community Development and are considered a part of this Permit.

This Permit is for well construction only, and does not waive any provisions or regularized requirements of the Water Use Act of 1967, or any other applicable laws or regulations.

Construction of a well under this Permit shall be in compliance with the North Carolina Well Construction Regulations and Standards, and any other laws and regulations pertaining to well construction.

This Permit will be effective from the date of its issuance until April 8, 1983 and shall be subject to other specified conditions, limitations, or exceptions as follows:

Advance notice of the pumping test date must be given to Rick Shiver (919) 256-4161 at least 24 hours before the start of the test.
