Synthetic organic chemicals

The water systems aboard MCB are required to be monitored for 36 synthetic organic chemicals (SOCs) at least every five years. This was done at the two large water systems serving the Industrial Area, Camp Johnson and the main housing areas at Camp Lejeune and the water system serving MCAS, New River and Camp Geiger during December 1987 and again during March 1989. The three smaller water systems serving Onslow Beach, Courthouse Bay and the Rifle Range were done during March 1989.
