Mr. Smith:

As per our previous phone conversation I have enclosed the following information for your review and approval. They are as follows:

1. An invoice which will be sent to Camp Lejeune for payment of the county tap fee prior to commencement of work.
2. A copy of three bid proposals from Herring & Rivenbark, Inc., Onslow Construction & Utility Company, and True Line. You will note that the quotes range from \$12,000.00 to \$18,845.00. With the low bid being \$12,000.00 this will be the one accepted by the county.
3. In addition, there is an engineering fee of \$850.00 that has been negotiated with Hoggard/Eure Associates. These are the same engineers that are doing the design of the project located within the boundaries of Marine Corp. Base Camp Lejeune.
4. Also enclosed in Section 2 is the Onslow County Water Ordinance for taps larger than 2".
5. A copy of the proposed invoice for \$13,350.00 is enclosed which incorporates the cost of the tap by True Line, the cost of engineering fees by Hoggard/Eure Associates, and the \$500.00 tap fee by the county.

If the enclosed meets the satisfaction of your office and the Marine Corp. Base Camp Lejeune, please give written response so that this office may proceed with the mailing of the invoice. Additionally, please furnish this office the name and address to which this invoice needs to be sent.

Upon notification I will need to have submitted the name of the local contact aboard Marine Corp. Base Camp Lejeune so as to set up the time


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frame of which this work will be accomplished. If there are any questions or additional information is needed, please don't hesitate to call or write this office.
