Subj: Request for Water Distribution System Data, 1965-1967

The following request for information is based on the ATSDR Public Health Assessment and the comprehensive study by ATSDR on the presence of volatile organic compounds in the MCB drinking water and adverse pregnancy outcomes. My family endured a fetal outcome since my son was born with heart malformation consistent with in utero exposure to VOC contamination. My family lived in [Redacted] in mid 1965 and later moved to [Redacted] which we vacated in July 1967. The exact dates should be available from the Base Housing Office.

During the years 1965, 1966, and 1967 where did the water provided to these noted areas originate? The data I have shows it could have come from the Holcomb Baldrige facility or the Hedden Point facility or could be a blend of water pumped from both locations.

Given that the MCL figures for both facilities were incredibly high for TCE, DCE and PCE perhaps it doesn't matter; however, we would like to know what your records indicate for the years noted as to how the distribution system operated and where the blending process took place.
