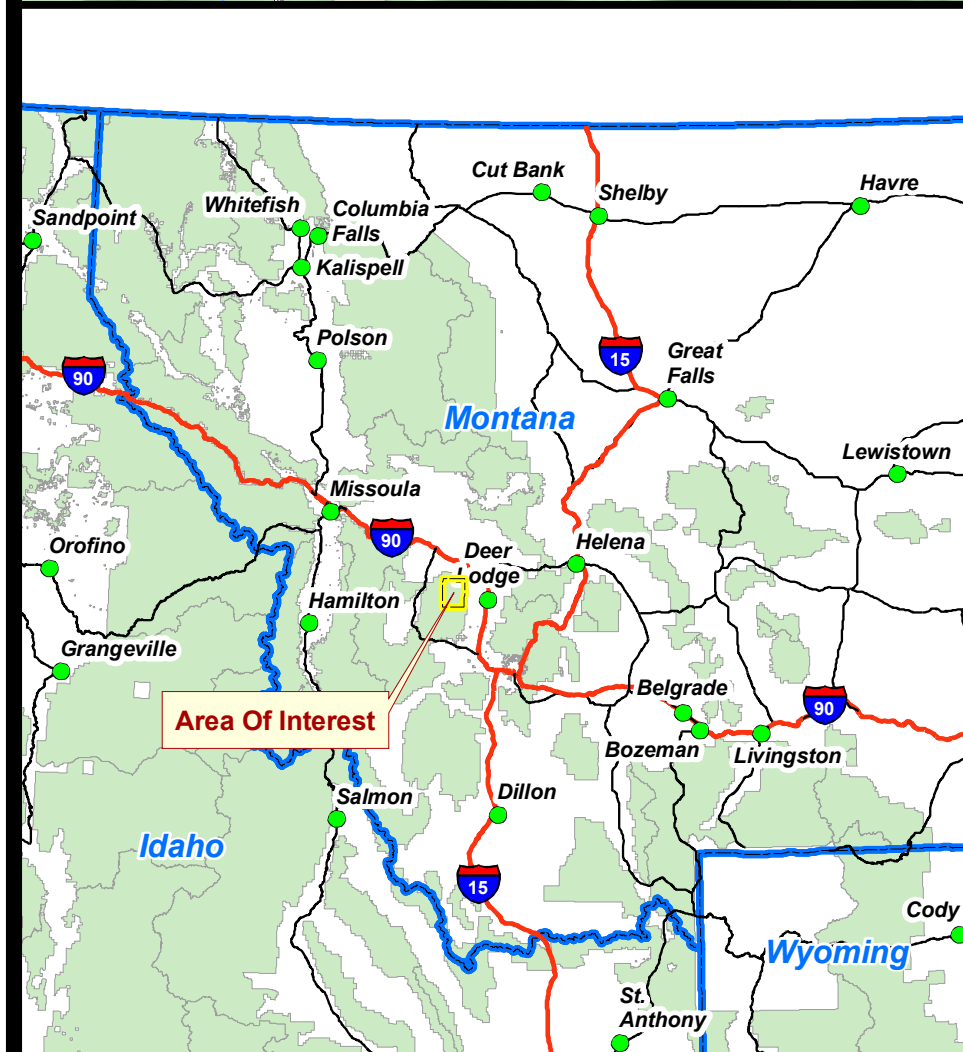


Dolus Lakes Wilderness
