

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5887
OFFERED BY MR. LANDRY OF LOUISIANA

Page 19, after line 21, insert the following (and conform the table of contents accordingly):

1 **SEC. 305. NAVIGABILITY DETERMINATION.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
3 date of enactment of this Act, the Commandant of the
4 Coast Guard shall submit to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the House of Representatives
5 and the Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation of the Senate a report on the impact of additional
6 regulatory requirements imposed on passenger vessels operating on the Ringo Cocks Canal in Louisiana as a result
7 of the covered navigability determination.

8 (b) RESTRICTION.—Before the date that is 180 days
9 after the date on which the report required under subsection (a) is submitted, the Commandant may not enforce
10 any regulatory requirements imposed on passenger vessels operating on the Ringo Cocks Canal in Louisiana that are
11 a result of the covered navigability determination.

12 (c) COVERED NAVIGABILITY DETERMINATION DEFINED.—In this section, the term “covered navigability
13 determination” means the Coast Guard’s Navigability De-

1 termination for Ringo Cocke Canal, Louisiana, dated
2 March 25, 2010.
