House Resolution 562 Introduced by Congresswoman Sewell Passes Unanimously



Recently, we passed bi-partisan House Resolution 562 acknowledging the historical significance of the Selma-to-Montgomery marches of 1965. This resolution directs the Office of the Historian of the United States House of Representatives to compile oral histories from current and former Members of Congress involved in the Selma to Montgomery marches as well as the Civil Rights Movement, for the purposes of expanding and augmenting the historic record for public dissemination and education. <u>Click here</u> to view press release.
