WASHINGTON – Today, Dave Obey (D-WI), Chairman of the House Appropriations Committee, issued the following response to the President's statement on Iraq.

"This month the Congress has passed a \$459 billion Defense bill and an additional \$11.6 billion for mine resistant vehicles. \$50 billion more in war funding was passed by the House and is available immediately, but the President must be willing to accept a few conditions.

- 1. "Our soldiers must be fully equipped and fully trained.
- 2. "Government employees must follow the Army Field Manual guidelines prohibiting torture.
- 3. "The President must come up with a responsible plan to bring our troops home from Iraq by December of 2008.
