Description	Unemployment Insurance (UI) provides temporary unemployment benefits to
	eligible workers that have lost their job through no fault of their own. The
	individual must also be currently seeking employment, in approved training, or
	awaiting recall to employment. In Wisconsin, some workers may be eligible
	for an extension of unemployment benefits under the federal emergency
	unemployment compensation (EUC). This provides up to 34 weeks of
	unemployment compensation. Because of the current economic situation in
	Wisconsin, Wisconsin also qualifies for an additional 13 weeks of
	unemployment benefits for a total of 47 weeks of emergency unemployment
	compensation. There is also Extended Benefits (EB) when EUC is exhausted.
	Extended Benefits offers 13 more weeks of unemployment and an additional 7
	when Wisconsin is in a period of high unemployment. Wisconsin entered such
	a period the week ending June 13, 2009
