Dear Chairwoman Emerson:

I appreciate the hard work that you, Ranking Member Serrano, and the rest of the members of the Financial Services Appropriations Subcommittee put in to the development of the FY2013 Financial Services Appropriations bill (H.R. 6020).

Unfortunately, your counterparts on the Senate Financial Services Appropriations Subcommittee have attempted to establish policy on an appropriations bill by directing in Senate Report 112-177 that the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) weigh in on online privacy issues. Consumer online privacy is an important subject and the authorizing committees in both the House and Senate are examining the subject in multiple subcommittees. Any new legislation considered in this area should be fully deliberated by Congress through regular order. I therefore respectfully request that the Statement of Managers to accompany the conference report on the FY2013 Financial Services Appropriations bill delete this authorizing language regarding privacy and reflect the fact that the authorizing committees in both the House and Senate are in the process of examining this issue and have not yet taken a position.
