Protecting Health Care Coverage for At Least 300,000 Low-Income Children and Lowering the Deficit by Eliminating Certain Tax Subsidies for Big Oil

Ms. Castor moves that the Committee on the Budget direct its Chairman to request on behalf of the Committee that the rule for consideration of the Sequester Replacement Reconciliation Act of 2012 make in order an amendment that would strike from Title II of the bill section 213, which repeals the maintenance of effort requirements for children in the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) and children and adults in Medicaid; and section 215, which repeals CHIP performance bonus payments; and replaces them with a provision that increases revenue by eliminating a wasteful tax break that encourages big oil companies to produce oil in foreign countries rather than here at home.
